**A RESOLUTION
BY CITY UTILITIES COMMITTEE**

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ATLANTA AND ATLANTA BELTLINE, INC. ("ABI") FOR ABI TO PROVIDE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE EDGEWOOD AVENUE BRIDGE PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Development Authority ("ADA") was designated as the redevelopment agency for the City of Atlanta's Tax Allocation District Number Six; the Beltline TAD; and

WHEREAS, Atlanta Beltline, Inc ("ABI") has been formed by the Atlanta Development Authority ("ADA") to perform certain ADA redevelopment responsibilities with respect to the BeltLine TAD and to serve as an agent of ADA; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta will receive Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) as a part of the issuance of the \$22,776,000 of Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds for the purpose of replacing the existing Edgewood Avenue Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the existing bridge runs perpendicular to and spans across the Atlanta Beltline corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta and the ABI desire that a new bridge be designed and constructed on the shared boundary of the Inman Park and Old Fourth Ward neighborhoods, bridge superstructure and substructure identified by Georgia Department of Transportation as Structure I.D. 121-0024-0 at Location 121-0918-001.42E on Edgewood Avenue between Arline Street, NE and Krog Street, and more specifically provide maximum connectivity for users of the BeltLine Corridor and Edgewood Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta desires the involvement of the ABI in the development of the area comprising the project and ABI wants to work with the City to manage the design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction work associated with the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta therefore wishes to enter into a Transportation Improvement Agreement with the ABI, an agent for ADA, to oversee and contract for the design, rights-of-way acquisition, and construction of the Edgewood Avenue Bridge Project.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into a Transportation Improvement Agreement (“Agreement”) between the City of Atlanta and Atlanta Beltline Inc., an agent for the Atlanta Development Authority, to design, acquire all necessary rights-of-way, and construct the Edgewood Avenue Bridge Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to prepare the appropriate Agreement for execution by the Mayor.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Agreement will not become binding upon the City and the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until the Agreement is approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to Atlanta Beltline, Inc.
