


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO ACCEPT FOUR GRANTS FOR THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS (\$280,913.00) FROM YOUTHBUILD USA FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING GUIDANCE AND ASSISTANCE FOR LOW-INCOME YOUNG PEOPLE AGES 16-24 WITH LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNITY SERVICE TRAINING WHILE WORKING TOWARD GETTING THEIR GED OR HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA; AND OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") administers special programs under contract to the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency ("AWDA"); and

WHEREAS, YouthBuild USA have supported and agreed to the transfer of the Metro Atlanta YouthBuild program to AWDA (attached hereto as Exhibit "A"); and

WHEREAS, YouthBuild USA have agreed to award AWDA the following grants (attached hereto as Exhibit "B") to support the YouthBuild USA programs;

WHEREAS, AWDA recommends that the City accept said funds to assist in its execution of providing assistance to the many young citizens of the City of Atlanta who will greatly benefit from this Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

**Section 1:** The Mayor or his designee, on behalf of the City of Atlanta, is authorized to accept four grants from YouthBuild USA for the total amount of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Nine Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$280,913.00) for the purpose of providing guidance and assistance for low-income young people ages 16-24 with leadership development and community service training while working toward getting their GED or high school diploma.

**Section 2:** That the 2012 (Intergovernmental Grant Fund) Budget for Atlanta Workforce Development Agency is hereby amended as follows:

Dear Ms. Lum,

YouthBuild USA is pleased to support the transfer of the Metro Atlanta YouthBuild program to the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency (AWDA). We hope for the seamless and successful transition of the Metro Atlanta YouthBuild program into the Youth Services Division of AWDA and expect the long term partnership arrangement to benefit the program, your agency and the young people of Atlanta.

Furthermore, given our understanding of the program design and delivery plans for the future work of Metro Atlanta YouthBuild, we are pleased to indicate that YouthBuild USA expects to continue ongoing programmatic support for the program. Specifically, YouthBuild USA currently manages pass-through grants to Metro Atlanta YouthBuild within four funded initiatives, and we expect to continue these investments as described below.

### **AmeriCorps Grant**

Through the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS), YouthBuild USA receives a "national direct" grant to support local programs like Metro Atlanta YouthBuild for engaging young people as YouthBuild AmeriCorps members to complete service in their community and build affordable homes for low-income people. Metro Atlanta YouthBuild is nearing the end of their 2010-2011 AmeriCorps grant and the YouthBuild USA AmeriCorps department anticipates that the 2011-2012 AmeriCorps grant award for Metro Atlanta will remain \$130,000 (grant period runs from 8/15/2011 – 8/14/2012).

### **Volunteers in Service to America (VISTA) Support**

Through another grant with CNCS, YouthBuild USA supports the placement of Volunteers in Service to America (VISTA) members at participating YouthBuild programs. Metro Atlanta currently benefits from one VISTA member serving at the program until mid-August 2011. Next year, YouthBuild USA anticipates placing another VISTA member to serve at the program from August 2011-August 2012. The CNCS estimates the in-kind value of each VISTA member to be \$19,000 per VISTA placement.



### **Mentoring Grant**

Through the US Department of Justice's Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP), YouthBuild USA supports local YouthBuild programs like Metro Atlanta to create a mentoring program focused on 16 to 18 year old YouthBuild students. Currently, Metro Atlanta YouthBuild has approximately \$18,964 remaining on the current cycle one mentoring grant. In addition, the YouthBuild USA National Mentoring Alliance has granted a cycle two grant award of \$75,000 to Metro Atlanta YouthBuild, with a start date of 11/1/2011 running on a 15 month funding period.

### **Postsecondary Education Initiative Grant**

Finally, with the support of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, YouthBuild USA had made an investment to support Metro Atlanta YouthBuild program to improve the postsecondary pathways for more YouthBuild graduates to access and complete postsecondary credentials with labor market value. Metro Atlanta YouthBuild is currently in the third year of a three year grant in this initiative. Approximately \$65,913 of the 2011 grant for \$131,825 is due to Metro Atlanta in August 2011 based on successful performance and submission of the upcoming interim report and PSE data. YouthBuild USA will work with the program to submit another funding request to the Gates Foundation at the end of 2011 for potential funds to continue the work beyond the conclusion of this three-year grant.

The grant managers for each of these funded initiatives have been briefed by Lance Wise on current plans for moving each respective scope of work forward at Metro Atlanta YouthBuild. We hope and believe that the partnership with AWDA as the new parent agency will strengthen and improve the overall quality of program delivery. Furthermore, we welcome the active engagement of you and your agency as a valuable and important partner in supporting the work of Metro Atlanta YouthBuild and YouthBuild USA.

We thank you and the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency for your willingness and ability to work with Lance Wise and his staff in support of the long term success of YouthBuild students and graduates in Atlanta. And we welcome you to a more expanded role as a member of the YouthBuild movement.
