AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE SOURCE SELECTION REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN SECTION 2-1187 OF ARTICLE X PROCUREMENT AND REAL ESTATE CODE OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES AND AUTHORIZING ALLIED AVIATION FUELING OF ATLANTA, INC. TO PROVIDE AND THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO ACCEPT FUEL STORAGE FACILITY AND FUELING FACILITY MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION SERVICES AT HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ON A MONTH TO MONTH BASIS BEGINNING ON NOVEMBER 29, 2011 UNDER THE TERMS OF AGREEMENT FC-7468-02 FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXTEND BEYOND JUNE 30, 2012 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,775,000.00 TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FDOA 5501 (AIRPORT REVENUE FUND) 5212001 (CONSULTING/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES) 180302 (MAINTENANCE AIRFIELD); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”)owns and operates Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (“Airport”), which includes certain fuel storage facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into Agreement FC-7468-02 (the “Agreement”) with Allied Aviation Fueling of Atlanta, Inc. (“Allied”) pursuant to Resolution 05-R-0695 for the management and operation of the City Fuel Farm and the North Cargo Jet-A, auto gas and diesel fuel facility at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (“Airport”); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement had a term of five (5) years which was to expire on March 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Allied has performed satisfactorily under the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer granted a 90-day extension pursuant to Section 2-1206 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances, extending the expiration of the Agreement to May 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 11-O-0640, the City Council of Atlanta authorized the month to month extension of the Agreement through November 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, airlines operating at the Airport have expressed a desire to manage and operate fuel storage facilities at the Airport via formation of an airline fuel consortium similar to those operating at other airports, and the airlines and Airport have formed a working group to evaluate this possibility; and

WHEREAS, the City has, more recently, issued Request for Proposal FC-5303; Fuel Storage Facility and Fueling Facility Operation and Management, which is currently underway, to select a new operator; and

WHEREAS, Allied is willing to continue providing services under the Agreement until a new operator is selected so that fuel storage management and operation services at the Airport continue uninterrupted; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation General Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer have recommended that Allied be authorized to provide and the City to accept fuel storage management and operation services for the Airport on a month to month basis for a period not to extend beyond June 30, 2012.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 2-1187 of Article X Procurement and Real Estate Code of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances is waived to the extent of any conflict with this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: That Allied Aviation Fueling of Atlanta, Inc. is authorized to provide and the City of Atlanta is authorized to accept fuel storage facility and fueling facility management and operation services at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport on a month to month basis beginning on November 29, 2011 under the terms of Agreement FC-7468-02 for a period not to extend beyond June 30, 2012 in an amount not to exceed \$1,775,000.00.

SECTION 3: That all such payments will be charged to and paid from FDOA 5501 (Airport Revenue Fund) 5212001 (Consulting/Professional Services) 180302 (Maintenance Airfield).

SECTION 4: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, including but not limited to Sections 2-1187 of the City of Atlanta Code of ordinances, are waived to the extent of the conflict only.
