A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY COMPUTERS, IN ADDITION TO TECHNICAL SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE FROM THE U.S. MICRO CORPORATION VALUED AT APROXIMATELY SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$600,000.00) FOR USE AT CITY OF ATLANTA RECREATION CENTERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs (“DPRCA”) provides a number of amenities and recreational programs to City of Atlanta (“City”) residents on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Centers of Hope, a program implemented by Mayor Kasim Reed, the City is invested in providing a comprehensive network of high quality programming for its youth to help achieve excellence; and

WHEREAS, numerous individuals, organizations and corporations share the City’s desire to support youth and wish to contribute to the City’s Centers of Hope; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Micro Corporation (“U.S. Micro”) is a leading information technology corporation that believes in the power of community and supports community efforts to enrich and improve the lives of others by providing technology to expand the minds of younger generations; and

WHEREAS, U.S. Micro approached the City with a proposal to donate 550 computers, software, accessories, and technical support and assistance valued at approximately Six Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$600,000.00) at all City recreation centers; and

WHEREAS, the City would greatly benefit from this donation and is appreciative of the generosity of U.S. Micro.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor, on behalf of the City, is authorized to accept the donation of 550 computers, software, accessories, technical support and assistance from U.S. Micro Corporation valued at approximately Six Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$600,000.00).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that to the extent that U.S. Micro is donating time and resources to the City, the City hereby accepts the donation.
