A RESOLUTION TO ADJUST AND CLARIFY THE NUMBER OF PERSONS DESIGNATED TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE ATAG II GROUP (ALCOHOL TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP II) AND TO AMEND RESOLUTION 11-R-0936 ACCORDINGLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Alcohol Technical Advisory Group II (ATAG II) was created pursuant to Resolution 11-R-0936; and

WHEREAS, said resolution provided that three (3) of the members of the group are to be representatives from the alcoholic beverage industry; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 11-R-1175 provided that one (1) of the alcoholic beverage industry representatives shall be appointed by the National Association of Licensing and Compliance Professionals (NALCP); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 11-R-1176 provided that one (1) of the alcoholic beverage industry representatives shall be appointed by the Georgia Alcohol Dealers Association (GADA) and one (1) shall be appointed by the Georgia Licensed Beverage Association (GALBA); and

WHEREAS, subsequent to identifying the three entities to be requested to appoint one each of the three industry representatives, a fourth entity (the Georgia Restaurant Association [GRA]) expressed an interest in appointing a representative to the ATAG II group; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 11-R-1407, GRA was added as the fourth industry entity to have an appointment to the ATAG II; and

WHEREAS, the appointment of one (1) industry representative by GRA necessitates an additional modification to the original resolution 11-R-0936.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

The number of industry representatives to be appointed to serve on the Alcohol Technical Advisory Group II (ATAG II) is hereby increased from three (3) to four (4) and the total number of members to be appointed to serve on the Alcohol Technical Advisory Group II
