A RESOLUTION TO EXPRESS THE INTENT OF THE ATLANTA CITY COUNCIL TO COLLABORATE WITH THE ATLANTA BOARD OF EDUCATION ON MATTERS OF MUTUAL CONCERN TO THE CITY, THE SCHOOL SYSTEM AND THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, City Council President Caesar Mitchell and Board of Education Chairwomen Brenda Muhammad, called a meeting between the members of the Atlanta City Council and members of the Atlanta Board of Education to discuss matters of mutual concern; and

WHEREAS, members of the City Council and members of the Board of Education both represent the taxpayers and citizens of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, that meeting was held on Thursday, October 13, 2011; and

WHEREAS, APS Interim Superintendent Erroll Davis joined the discussion; and

WHEREAS, there are so many positive ways the City and the Board of Education can collaborate for the benefit of our youth; and

WHEREAS, matters of mutual concern to both the council and the school board pertain to matters which are programmatic, operational and fiscal in nature; and

WHEREAS, the topics discussed at the meeting were (1) the upcoming E-SPLOST referendum, a 1-cent schools sales tax renewal up for a vote in November in order to generate funds primarily to be used for school construction and renovation; (2) the City's population shifts and its impact on public schools; (3) City Council and School Board redistricting; (4) better coordination of the efforts of the City and the School Board in combating truancy; (5) school choice; (6) the return of the APS magnet school program; and (7) the remediation program for students affected by the CRCT cheating situation and such other areas of mutual concern which are beneficial to the citizens and taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and the School Board have historically operated independently; and

WHEREAS, both the City and the School System, as well as the public and the community at large, can greatly benefit as a result of this cooperation partnership and collaboration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA THAT the Atlanta City Council hereby expresses its intent to formally cooperate, work with and collaborate with the Atlanta Board of Education on matters of mutual concern to the city, the school system and the community at large.
