BRENT M. BROWN'S BIO

Brent Brown was born November 9, 1970 at Crawford Long Hospital in Atlanta, Georgia.

After graduating in 1990 from Woodward Academy in College Park, Georgia, Brent attended the Georgia Institute of Technology where he graduated in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science and Management. While at Georgia Tech, Brent was part of the co-op program and worked seven quarters at the corporate headquarters of The Coca-Cola Company in Atlanta, Georgia. Also during this time, Brent interned in Washington, DC for the late Senator Paul Coverdell.

Brent received his Master of Business Administration in 1997 from the University of Georgia in Athens, Georgia with a specialization in Marketing, Advertising & Entrepreneurship. Brent served as the Class President. Upon graduating from UGA, Brent joined the campaign team of "People With Guy Millner" and served as Guy Millner's personal aide when he ran for Governor of the state of Georgia in 1998.

Brent ran for Labor Commissioner for the state of Georgia in 2002 and 2006. In 2002, he received 190,330 votes (48%) of the vote in the Republican primary. He was endorsed by the Atlanta Journal Constitution, the Savannah Morning News and the Valdosta Daily Times. In 2006, he won the Republican primary with over 70% for the vote, carrying 157 of the 159 counties. In the general election, he received over 929,000 votes.

Brent received an executive appointment from Governor Sonny Perdue to the Stone Mountain Memorial Association Board, one of Georgia's premier state parks and attractions. Brent has served on the Finance Committee since 2005 and in 2011 was asked to serve as Chair of the Finance Committee.

Having been in the account receivable management industry for close to 10 years, Brent currently serves as the Director Business Development – Government Division for Harris & Harris, Ltd., a privately held accounts receivable management firm headquarter in Chicago.

Brent is married to Pamela G. Brown and has two daughters, Madeline F. Brown and Natalie M. Brown. Brent and his family are members of the Cathedral of Christ the King. The Brown family resides in the Peachtree Hills neighborhood where he is an active member of the Peachtree Hills Civic Association.

Being born and raised in the city of Atlanta, Brent takes great pride in his home and wants to help make Atlanta one of the most clean and beautiful cities in the world. Brent has taken on several personal projects relating to improving how the city looks and feels. Recently he finished a major project at the intersection of Peachtree Road and Peachtree Hills Avenue/Fairhaven Circle, one of the main thoroughfares in Atlanta and the entrance to his neighborhood. He spearheaded the effort to clean up, re-landscape, and preserve a site which includes two Civil War plaques. Brent looks forward to the beautification of the communities in a more organized and city-wide effort.
