

**A RESOLUTION  
BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT BROWNFIELD ASSESSMENT AND BROWNFIELDS REVOLVING LOAN FUND (RLF) GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) IN AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$800,000.00) TO ADDRESS SITES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS CONTAMINATED BY PETROLEUM AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, City of Atlanta has a brownfield assessment grant and a brownfield revolving loan fund for cleanup of hazardous and petroleum sites in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Brownfield Assessment grants provide funding to inventory, characterize, assess, and conduct planning (including area-wide planning and cleanup planning) and community involvement related to brownfield sites; and

**WHEREAS**, Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) grants provide funding to capitalize a revolving fund and to make loans and provide sub-grants to carry out cleanup activities at brownfield sites that might otherwise be left undeveloped, thereby contributing to the supply of land needed to meet the demands of the City's projected growth in population and jobs; and

**WHEREAS**, Brownfield Cleanup grants provide funding for a grant recipient to carry out cleanup activities at brownfield sites that are assessed as hazardous; and

**WHEREAS**, the redevelopment of brownfields is an important element of City planning documents, including but not limited to, the Comprehensive Development Plan, and the Beltline Redevelopment Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, assessment of these properties protects the environment, reduces blight, and contributes to the City's greenspace acreage; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, through previous assessment grants awarded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), has identified and assessed potential brownfield sites throughout the City as the first step in the process of reclaiming and redeveloping brownfield properties; and

**WHEREAS**, through such assessment efforts, the City has identified an estimated 950 brownfield properties within the City of which there are approximately 140 brownfields along the Beltline and another 40 in the other targeted corridors; and

**WHEREAS**, the EPA is requiring that all local governments must submit new grant applications for continued funding by November 28, 2011; and



**WHEREAS**, the City's Office of Planning proposes to submit grant applications for assessment and cleanup activities at brownfield sites and provide the required twenty percent ( 20%) match for cleanup grants when awarded.

**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES** to authorize the Mayor or his designee, on behalf of the City, to submit Brownfield Assessment and Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund grant applications to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in an aggregate amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000.00) to thereafter be used to conduct assessment and cleanup activity on sites within City limits.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City will provide the required twenty percent (20%) match for any RLF grant funded by the U.S. EPA for cleanup purposes.
