RESOLUTION

12-R-0617 (1) A Resolution by **Councilmembers Felicia A. Moore, Michael Julian Bond and Natalyn Archibong** authorizing the Chief Procurement Officer to administratively extend contracts for food and beverage concessions under the current terms at Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport for a period of ninety (90) days to assure uninterrupted concession services while new concession contracts are being executed; and for other purposes.

Municipal Clerk Rhonda Dauphin Johnson sounded the caption to Resolution 12-R-0617. Following, Councilmember Young was recognized and made a Motion to Enter Executive Session to discuss potential litigation, pending legal matters as such regarding Resolution 12-R-0617. The Motion was Seconded by Councilmember Smith and CARRIED by a roll call vote of 11 yeas (Councilmembers Smith, Young, Archibong, Shook, Adrean, Moore, Martin, Bottoms, Bond, Watson and Willis); 0 nays; thus Council retreated into Executive Session.

Returning from Executive Session, a Motion was made to re-enter Regular Session. It was properly Seconded and the Motion CARRIED by a roll call vote of 10 yeas (Councilmembers Smith, Young, Archibong, Adrean, Moore, Martin, Bottoms, Bond, Watson and Willis); 0 nays. Council re-entered Regular Session.

During Regular Session, Councilmember Martin made a Motion to Adverse. It was Seconded by Councilmember Young and an extensive discussion ensued, in which, Councilmember Smith made a Substitute Motion to File. It was Seconded by Councilmember Young and discussion continued. During discussion, Councilmember Willis Called the Question. Subsequently, the Motion CARRIED by a roll call vote of 9 yeas; (Councilmembers Smith, Young, Archibong, Shook, Adrean, Moore, Martin, Bottoms and Willis); 1 nay; (Councilmember Bond). The Motion to File was then CARRIED by a roll call vote of 8 yeas; (Councilmembers Smith, Young, Archibong, Shook, Adrean, Martin, Bottoms
