Municipal Clerk Rhonda Dauphin Johnson sounded the caption to communication 12-C-0846. Following, Councilmember Moore was recognized and made a Motion to File. It was Seconded by Councilmember Wan and the Motion CARRIED by a roll call vote of 9 yeas; 0 nays.

Councilmember Moore, Chair of Finance/Executive Committee, made a Motion to Enter the Committee of the Whole to discuss the following budget related items. It was Seconded by Councilmember Wan and the Motion to Enter Committee of the Whole CARRIED by a roll call vote of 10 yeas (Councilmembers Smith, Hall, Young, Wan, Shook, Adrean, Moore, Martin, Bottoms and Sheperd); 0 nays. Council entered Committee of the Whole.

Within Committee of the Whole, Councilmember Moore made a Motion to open for a Public Hearing regarding the mileage rate. It was properly Seconded and CARRIED by a roll call vote of 10 yeas; (Councilmembers Smith, Young, Winslow, Wan, Shook, Adrean, Moore, Martin, Sheperd and Watson); 0 nays. It was Seconded by Councilmember Sheperd and a discussion ensued. During discussion, Councilmember Wan made a Substitute Motion to accept option 1 which correlates 80% toward employees' salaries mid-point grade. It was Seconded by Councilmember Adrean who offered a Friendly Amendment to revisit the 82.5%. Discussion continued, in which, Wan Amendment to accept option 1 FAILED by a roll call vote of 4 yeas; (Councilmembers Smith, Wan, Adrean and Moore); 6 nays; (Councilmembers Young, Winslow, Shook, Martin, Bottoms and Sheperd). Councilmember Martin Amendment was subsequently before the Council to accept option 2. The Motion then CARRIED by a roll call vote of 8 yeas; (Councilmembers Smith, Young, Winslow, Shook, Martin, Bottoms, Sheperd and Watson); 3 nays (Councilmembers Wan, Adrean and Moore). Following, Councilmember Moore made a Motion to Exit Committee of the Whole. It was properly Seconded and CARRIED by a roll call vote of 10 yeas; (Councilmembers Smith, Young, Winslow, Wan, Shook, Adrean, Moore, Bottoms, Sheperd and Watson); 0 nays. Council was now in Regular Session.
