**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 11-R-0770 SO AS TO EXTEND THE EXPIRATION DATE FOR THE TIRE COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, The Atlanta City Council adopted on May 16, 2011 the attached Resolution 11-R-0770 to create a Tire commission to study ways to manage illegal tire duping, increase the city's code enforcement and suggest language to amend the existing City Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tire Commission has started the dialogue with meetings focusing on illegal tire dumping control and prevention; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has received suggestions from members and citizens and studies from University of Georgia and Spelman College; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has accepted a list of recommendations from the University of Georgia to be acted upon, and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 11-R-1506 adopted by Council on November 7, 2011, approved an extension to the Tire Commission from September 30, 2011 to December 31, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission still needs time to continue the discussion and to complete the report with recommendations to the Mayor and City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Atlanta City Council wishes again to extend the expiration date for the Tire Commission from December 31, 2011 to December 31, 2012.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA** as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Section 4 in Resolution 11-R-0770 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A TIRE COMMISSION TO STUDY THE PROBLEM OF ILLEGAL TIRE DUMPING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta is faced with the problem of illegal tire dumping, which is getting worse every day; and

**WHEREAS**, thousands of tires are dumped throughout the city on streets, behind buildings and inside abandoned houses and warehouses; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to posing as a fire hazard, discarded tires often attract rodents, vermin, and insects such as mosquitoes, which carry diseases such as West Nile virus; and

**WHEREAS**, council members from the most affected districts organize and coordinate tire clean-ups periodically in their areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the collective quality of life in the City of Atlanta is decreased by the destruction caused by abandoned tires; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the public interest of the City of Atlanta to pursue vigorous program(s) to tackle the issue of improper disposal of tires in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to create a commission to study, and identify steps and actions that the City of Atlanta can take to better manage the ever growing problem of discarded tires.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That a Tire Commission is hereby created with ten (10) members to be appointed as follows:

- a. One member from the Community Development and Human Resources Committee
- b. One member appointed by Atlanta Planning Advisory Board (APAB)
- c. A representative from Atlanta Clean City Commission
- d. One member from the State Environmental Protection Division (EPD)
- e. One member from the Fulton County Health Department
- f. Director of Code Compliance or his designee
- g. Director of Solid Waste Services or his designee
- h. A city attorney designated by Atlanta City Attorney
- i. A staff person designated by the Police Chief
- j. A staff person from the City Courts/Community Prosecutor



**SECTION 2:** That the Commission shall study ways to manage illegal tire dumping, increase the city's code enforcement and suggest language to amend the existing City Code.

**SECTION 3:** That the Chief Service Officer from the Mayor's Office and the Office of Code Compliance shall provide the technical and administrative support for the Commission.

**SECTION 4:** That the Commission shall present a study with recommendations via a report to the Mayor and City Council no later than September 30, 2011, effectively ending the duty of the Commission.

**SECTION 5:** All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed for purposes of the resolutions only, and only to the extent of the conflict.


