A RESOLUTION

BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (“DEPARTMENT”), TO EXECUTE TEMPORARY SERVICE CONTRACTS WITH UP TO ONE HUNDRED FIFTY (150) RETIRED CITY OF ATLANTA POLICE OFFICERS, FOR ENHANCED SECURITY AT HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (“AIRPORT”), FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO FIFTEEN (15) MONTHS BEGINNING NO EARLIER THAN 1 MARCH 2012 AND ENDING NO LATER THAN 31 MAY 2013, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED A TOTAL OF TWO MILLION, FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND, EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$2,486,080); ALL COSTS TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM 5501 (AIRPORT REVENUE FUND), 240602 (APD AIRPORT), 5212001 (CONSULTING, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES), 3223000 (PATROL); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (“Airport”) is scheduled to open a new international terminal in 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Police Department (“Department”) has decided to enhance the security of Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (“Airport”) in preparation for the opening of the new international terminal at the Airport through the deployment of additional sworn police officers; and

WHEREAS, retired City of Atlanta (“City”) Police Department officers possess the knowledge, skills, abilities, and expertise necessary to provide the desired enhanced security at the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Department desires to execute temporary service contracts with up to one hundred fifty (150) retired City of Atlanta Police Officers (“agreements”) to enhance the security at the Airport, for a period of up to fifteen (15) months beginning no earlier than 1 March 2012 and ending no later than 31 May 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Airport has identified two million, four hundred eighty-six thousand, eighty dollars (\$2,486,080) from 5501 (Airport Revenue Fund), 240602 (APD Airport), 5212001 (Consulting, Professional Services), 3223000 (Patrol) to cover the costs of the agreements; and

WHEREAS, such engagements are authorized pursuant to Article 3, Chapter 5, Section 3-505 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute temporary service



contracts, on behalf of the Department of Police (“Department”), with up to one hundred fifty (150) retired City of Atlanta Police Officers (“agreements”) for the purpose of enhancing security at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, for a period of up to fifteen (15) months beginning no earlier than 1 March 2012 and ending no later than 31 May 2013, in an amount not to exceed two million, four hundred eighty-six thousand, eighty dollars (\$2,486,080).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all costs for the agreements with the one hundred fifty (150) retired City of Atlanta Police officers shall be charged to and paid from 5501 (Airport Revenue Fund), 240602 (APD Airport), 5212001 (Consulting, Professional Services), 3223000 (Patrol).


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the agreements shall have an initial term of fifteen (15) months. Payments will be disbursed in an amount not to exceed the following:

March 1, 2012 – June 30, 2012: \$662,954.67

July 1, 2012 – May 31, 2013: \$1,823,125.33

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that said agreements will not become binding upon the City and the City will incur no liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney, and delivered to the respective retired City of Atlanta Police Officers.

AGREEMENT

GEORGIA....CITY OF ATLANTA

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into as of the ___ day of _____, 20___, by and between the **CITY OF ATLANTA**, a municipal corporation of the State of Georgia (hereinafter referred to as the City), and the Retired Officers Assistance Program (ROAP) and (*RETIRED Officer Name*), of Atlanta Police Department (hereinafter referred to as **Retired Officers Name**.)

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, **Retired Officers Name**., retired as a Police Officer in the Police Department of City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Chief of Police desire to execute up to one hundred fifty (150) temporary service contracts to utilize the skills, knowledge, and expertise of (**Retired Officers Name**), to provide increase security with highly visible presence, professional services, and customer service through positive engagement for the City of Atlanta, at Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport and properties included there in, located at 6000 North Terminal Parkway, Atlanta, Georgia through a contractual agreement for services; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has certified the necessity of such contractual agreement in compliance with the requirements of Section 3-505 of the Charter of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the execution of this agreement, on the part of the City, has been authorized by Resolution/Ordinance No. _____, adopted by the City Council, and approved by the Mayor, in the form and manner of that copy of the same attached hereto as Appendix 1 and made a part hereof by reference.

HOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the premises and mutual covenants hereinafter contained, it is agreed between the parties hereto as follows:

1.

Retired Officers Name., agrees to provide increase security with highly visible presence, professional services, and customer service through positive engagement for the City of Atlanta as required by the Department of Police, at Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport and properties included there in, located at 6000 North Terminal Parkway, Atlanta, Ga. as directed.



2.

In consideration of such services, the City agrees to pay compensation to (**Retired Officers Name**), a Program Supervisor, to be computed at a rate of \$(30.00) per hour, for a total not to exceed \$69,000.00, over the term of the contract, to be paid from Account No. **1001 (General Fund), 240401 (APD Chief of Police), 5112002 (Salaries, Extra Help-Sworn), 32230000 (Patrol).**

3.

The Term of this agreement shall commence on March?, 2012, and shall continue thereafter for a period of twelve (15) months from March 2012 through May 2013; provided, however, that this agreement may be terminated by either party upon ten (10) business day's prior written notice to the other.

4.

(**Retired Officers Name**), agrees that he /she will remain in compliance with APD SOP 2190 Atlanta Retired Police Reserve, and APD SOP 2060 Extra Jobs, at all times during this agreement, any failure to adhere to this requirement may result in immediate termination of this agreement.

5.

(**Retired Officers Name**), agrees that the services hereunder shall not constitute reemployment by the City, and he/she shall not acquire any civil service rights, employee benefits, or any further pension rights by virtue of this Agreement. The City agrees that (**Retired Officers Name**). shall be entitled to continue to receive his regular pension payments, and that he will not be required to make any contribution to the pension fund by virtue of this Agreement.

6.

The parties agree that the term of this Agreement, as set forth herein, shall constitute the entire agreement between them. Changes, which may be mutually agreed upon by and between the City, the Retired Officers Assistance Program (ROAP) and (**Retired Officers Name**), shall be effective and enforceable, only after both parties, hereto, have executed a written amendment.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City, acting by and through its duly authorized officials, and (**Retired Officers Name**), have executed this Agreement as of this day and year first above written.
