**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH KIRLIA FIRE TRAINING FACILITIES, INC., FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE ATLANTA AIRPORT FIRE AND RESCUE TRAINING FACILITY, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 2-1191.1 SPECIAL PROCUREMENT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$240,000.00 AT HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. ALL SERVICES WILL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FDOA: 5501 (AIRPORT REVENUE FUND) 180303 (DOA AVIATION MAINTENANCE-TERMINAL) 5212001 (CONSULTING/PROFESSIONAL SERV) 7563000 (AIRPORT) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta (“City”), did execute Contract FC-4986 Operation and Maintenance of the Atlanta Airport Fire and Rescue Training Facility (the “Contract”) with Kirlia Fire Training Facilities, Inc. (“Kirlia”) effective January 11, 2010 as authorized by the Chief Procurement Officer under Code Section 2.1191.1 Special Procurement, and pursuant to Resolution 09-R-1627 adopted by the Council of the City September 21, 2009 and approved by the Mayor September 25, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of the Contract was for two (2) years and did not contain any renewals; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Aviation has determined that to continue this unique facility operating safely and reliably, additional Operation and Maintenance services, to be provided by Kirlia, are required; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Procurement Officer has extended the Contract for a ninety (90) day period through April 8, 2012 pursuant to the City’s Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Procurement Officer has determined that the Special Procurement authorization under Code Section 2.1191.1 is appropriate for the procurement of these services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aviation General Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that Kirlia be authorized to provide and the City to accept additional Operation and Maintenance services in support of the Atlanta Airport Fire and Rescue Training Facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that the Mayor is authorized to execute an Agreement with Kirlia Fire Training Facilities for Operation and Maintenance of the Atlanta Airport Fire and Rescue Training Facility for two (2) years effective April 9, 2012, in an amount not to exceed \$240,000.00, and that such Agreement may contain an option for the City to renew the Operation and Maintenance services at its sole discretion for an additional two



(2) years pursuant to approval by the Council of the City and the Mayor of the City of Atlanta.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all such contracted services will be charged to and paid from FDOA 5501 (Airport Revenue Fund) 180303 (DOA Aviation Maintenance-Terminal) 5212001 (consulting/professional Serv) 7563000 (Airport).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Attorney is directed to prepare an Agreement for execution by the Mayor

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Agreement will become effective, April 9, 2012; however, the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney and delivered to Kirlia, Inc.
