**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta's ("City"), as owner and operator of Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport ("the Airport") has entered into certain Lease Agreements, dated March 22, 1978, with various airlines serving the Airport ("Contracting Airlines"), which cover the planning, design, development, construction, maintenance, and operation of the Central Passenger Terminal Complex ("CPTC") at the Airport, with the City having responsibility for capital replacement items in the CPTC; and

**WHEREAS**, the Contracting Airlines formed Atlanta Airlines Terminal Corporation ("AATC") to manage and operate the jointly leased and common use areas of the CPTC, including mechanical plants, on behalf of the Airlines and the City collectively; and

**WHEREAS**, the Automated People Mover ("APM") Tunnel Structural Repairs Project ("Project") will execute structural repairs to the APM tunnel and guideways including: concrete expansion and construction joint repairs; concrete spall repairs; open crack repairs; closed crack repairs; power and guiderail support repairs; running surface concrete spall repairs; and running surface joint and crack repairs therefore mitigating further deterioration and maintenance issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that it is appropriate for AATC to assume responsibility for the Project and for the City to reimburse AATC for the costs of the Project.



**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA,** that the Mayor is authorized to execute a Reimbursable Agreement with AATC for the APM Tunnel Structural Repairs Project with the reimbursement of the cost thereof by the City to AATC up to a total amount not to exceed \$3,720,000.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that AATC complete all work on the APM Structural Repairs Project in a time not to exceed 365 calendar days from the date the project begins.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that all contracted work will be charged to and paid for from PTAE0: 18100289 (AGTS General Improvements) H0308041 (APM Tunnel Structural Repairs) 550291249 (DOA R N E 9999) 5414002 (Facilities Other Than Bldgs) and FDOA: 5502 (Airport Renewal and Extension Fund) 180201 (DOA Aviation Capital Planning & Development) 5414002 (facilities Other Than Bldgs) 7563000 (Airport) 100289 (AGTS General Improvements) 91249 (DOA R N E 9999) for \$3,266,854 and PTAE0: 18101352 (Terminal Improvements) 200 (Task) 550291249 (DOA R N E 9999) 5414002 (Facilities Other Than Bldgs) and FDOA: 5502 (Airport Renewal and Extension Fund) 180201 (DOA Aviation Capital Planning & Development) 5414002 (Facilities Other Than Bldgs) 7563000 (Airport) 101352 (Terminal Improvements) 91249 (DOA R N E 9999) FOR \$453,146.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the City Attorney is directed to prepare an appropriate agreement for execution by the Mayor.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Reimbursable Agreement will not become binding on the City and the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney and delivered to AATC.
