A SUBSTITUTE RESOLUTION REAUTHORIZING THE REEMPLOYMENT OF JOCELYN ROSS IN THE POSITION OF GRANTS ANALYST IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$31,564.00 PURSUANT TO SECTION 3-505(c) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs (“DPRCA”) has greatly increased its use of local and federal grants to supplement its capital improvements and operations for initiatives unaffordable to the City of Atlanta’s (“City”) General Fund Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 10-R-1491 (copy attached), which was adopted on September 7, 2010 and approved by operation of Law per Section 2-403 of the City Charter on September 16, 2010, which authorized the reemployment of a retired employee, Jocelyn Ross for a period not to exceed 375 business days; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-505(c)(1) of the City Charter authorizes the reemployment of a retired employee for a period not to exceed 520 business days; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-505(c)(3) of the City Charter also requires that a period of reemployment shall not exceed 120 business days without reauthorization by the city council; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Ross has provided invaluable knowledge and expertise in the area of grants and federal compliance issues on behalf of DPRCA on a part-time basis; and

WHEREAS, as of February 1, 2012, Ms. Ross has served 226.3 business days and through inadvertence, she was allowed to serve beyond the 120 day required reauthorization period; and

WHEREAS, 148.7 of the 375 business days remain from the reemployment authorization as set forth in Resolution 10-R-1491; and

WHEREAS, DPRCA wishes to continue the reemployment of Ms. Ross on the same part-time work schedule not to exceed 20 hours per week, to close out existing grants, achieve federal compliance, and transition her workload to other DPRCA employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs is hereby reauthorized to continue the reemployment of Jocelyn Ross, a retired employee of the City of Atlanta, as a Grants Analyst, for a period not to exceed 148.7 business days, at Pay Grade 21, for a part-time salary of \$31,546.00 as provided by Section 3-505(c) of the City Charter.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the salary of Ms. Ross shall be charged to and paid from: 3501 (Park Improvement Fund) 140106 (PRC Park Design) 5112001 (Salary; Extra Help) 6220000 (Park Areas).
