AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 150, ARTICLE IV, DIVISION 3, SECTION 150-133 OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES TO SPECIFY THE AMOUNT OF THE FINES FOR OVERTIME PARKING AT METERED SPACES THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF ATLANTA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta wishes to make certain changes to its on-street parking meter program to facilitate the efficient operation of metered parking to benefit residents, business owners, visitors, patrons of the arts and all members of the public; and

WHEREAS, one element of such changes is to include the specific amount of fines to be assessed against violators of the overtime parking provisions set out at Section 150-133 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 150, Article IV, Division 3, Section 150-133 which reads as follows:

Sec. 150-133. - Overtime parking.

- (a) No person shall park any motor vehicle in any area where a parking meter is installed for a longer period of time than the maximum time indicated for the area by an appropriate sign.
- (b) The municipal court is authorized to impose a civil monetary penalty against persons who violate this section in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 for each such violation.

Shall be revised in bold and strikeout text to read as follows:

Sec. 150-133. - Overtime parking.

- (a) No person shall park any motor vehicle in any area where a parking meter is installed for a longer period of time than **has been paid for or** the maximum time indicated for the area by an appropriate sign.



- (b) When a violation as described in subsection (a) above occurs, a citation for overtime parking shall be issued and a fine of \$35.00 shall be imposed.**
- (c) If the mandatory \$35.00 fine set out in subsection (b) above is not paid in full within fourteen days of the issuance of the citation, the fine shall increase from \$35.00 to \$70.00.**
- (d) If the \$70.00 fine set out in subsection (c) above is not paid in full within forty-five days of the issuance of the citation, the fine shall increase from \$70.00 to \$95.00.**
- (~~b~~e) Should the violator elect to appeal the issuance of the citation described herein to the municipal court, ~~the~~ the municipal court, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances, is authorized to impose a civil monetary penalty against persons who violate this section in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 for each such violation. Upon the proper filing of an appeal within 14 days of the issuance of the citation, the late fees described in subsections (c) and (d) above will be suspended.**

Section 150-133, as revised above will then be codified as follows:

Sec. 150-133. - Overtime parking.

- (a) No person shall park any motor vehicle in any area where a parking meter is installed for a longer period of time than has been paid for or the maximum time indicated for the area by an appropriate sign.
- (b) When a violation as described in subsection (a) above occurs, a citation for overtime parking shall be issued and a fine of \$35.00 shall be imposed.
- (c) If the mandatory \$35.00 fine set out in subsection (b) above is not paid in full within fourteen days of the issuance of the citation, the fine shall increase from \$35.00 to \$70.00.
- (d) If the \$70.00 fine set out in subsection (c) above is not paid in full within forty-five days of the issuance of the citation, the fine shall increase from \$70.00 to \$95.00.
- (e) Should the violator elect to appeal the issuance of the citation described herein to the municipal court, the municipal court, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances, is authorized to impose a civil monetary penalty against persons who violate this section in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 for each such violation. Upon the proper filing of an appeal within 14 days of the issuance of the citation, the late fees described in subsections (c) and (d) above will be suspended.



Section 2: Should it be found that any ordinance or parts of any ordinance are in conflict herewith, then those sections contained herein shall be deemed controlling.
