**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT (“APD”), TO ACCEPT TEN (10) MOBILE ALL-IN-ONE RAPID ID DEVICES VALUED AT THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$31,990), FROM THE STATE OF GEORGIA, AT NO COST TO THE CITY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENHANCING THE STATE OF GEORGIA’S RAPID ID NETWORK, AND TO SUPPORT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY EFFORTS OF THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Georgia received funding from the United States Department of Homeland Security, through the FY 2009 Homeland Security Grant Program (“grant”); and

**WHEREAS**, through the grant, the State of Georgia wishes to provide the Atlanta Police Department ten (10) Mobile All-in-One Rapid ID devices, valued at thirty-one thousand, nine hundred ninety dollars (\$31,990), at no cost to the City of Atlanta, in order to enhance the State Rapid ID Network, and allow Atlanta Police Department officers to rapidly and accurately establish the identity of persons they encounter in the field who are suspected of criminal or terrorist activity; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to provide the Atlanta Police Department with ten (10) Mobile All-in-One Rapid ID devices under a grant awarded to the State of Georgia, the Georgia Emergency Management Agency (“GEMA”) has requested the City of Atlanta’s consent to allow GEMA to retain and use thirty-one thousand, nine hundred ninety dollars (\$31,990) of the FY 2009 Homeland Security Grant Program funds awarded to the State of Georgia to purchase the ten (10) Mobile All-in-One Rapid ID devices on behalf of the City of Atlanta (“Attachment A”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police recommends consenting to allowing GEMA to retain and use thirty-one thousand, nine hundred ninety dollars (\$31,990) of the FY 2009 Homeland Security Grant Program funds awarded to the State of Georgia to purchase the ten (10) Mobile All-in-One Rapid ID devices on behalf of the City of Atlanta (“Attachment A”); and to accept the ten (10) Mobile All-in-One Rapid ID devices, to enhance the Atlanta Police Department’s ability to detect, deter, and respond to criminal and terrorist activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That the Mayor or his designee, on behalf of the City of Atlanta (“City”), is hereby authorized to sign the consent form (“Attachment A”), to allow the Georgia Emergency Management Agency (“GEMA”) to retain and use thirty-one thousand, nine hundred ninety



dollars (\$31,990) of the FY 2009 Homeland Security Grant Program funds awarded to the State of Georgia, to purchase the ten (10) Mobile All-in-One Rapid ID devices on behalf of the Atlanta Police Department, and to accept the devices, at no cost to the City.

**Section 2:** That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby waived for purposes of this resolution only, and only to the extent of the conflict.
