**A RESOLUTION
BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SEPARATE CONTRACT AMENDMENTS WITH THE ATLANTA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY DOING BUSINESS AS INVEST ATLANTA (IA), GEORGIA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, AND THE ATLANTA BELTLINE, INC. (ABI) FOR THE BROWNFIELDS SMALL AREA-WIDE PLANNING PILOT GRANT PROGRAM SO AS TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THESE CONTRACTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 10-R-2009, the City entered into separate contracts with the Atlanta Development Authority doing business as Invest Atlanta (IA), the Georgia Institute of Technology, and the Atlanta Beltline, Inc. (ABI) on January 27, 2011 for the Brownfields small area-wide planning pilot grant; and

WHEREAS, each respective contract is set to expire on September 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, IA, Georgia Tech, and ABI have made substantial progress in completing the planning effort and the Department of Planning and Community Development recommends that the term of each of the contracts be extended until December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency approved the City's request for a grant extension to December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, no provision of the contracts is proposed for amendment other than the extended term authorized herein.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES that the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into contractual amendment number 1 with the Atlanta Development Authority (doing business as Invest Atlanta), Georgia Institute of Technology, and the Atlanta Beltline, Inc., for the Brownfields small area-wide planning pilot grant, so as to extend the term of each separate contract until December 31, 2012.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, no provision of the contracts other than the extended term authorized herein shall be amended pursuant to this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney be and is hereby directed to prepare appropriate amendment for execution by the Mayor.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the contract amendment shall not become binding upon the City and the City will incur no liability upon the same under it until such contract amendment is approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to each of the contracting parties.
