**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL TO
THE OPERATING AND LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ATLANTA
AND EAST ATLANTA KIDS CLUB, INC.; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the East Atlanta Kids Club, Inc., (“EAKC”) is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing after-school mentoring and weekend programs such as recreational, educational, and cultural activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”) owns and operates the Brownwood Park Recreation Center and the Brownwook Park located at 602 Brownwood Avenue, SE Atlanta, Georgia 30316 (“Center”); and

WHEREAS, the City and EAKC (collectively the “Parties”) entered into an Operating and Lease Agreement (“Agreement”) as authorized by Resolution 09-R-1125, adopted by the City Council on July 20, 2009 and approved by Mayor Shirley Franklin on July 28, 2009 to provide after-school mentoring and weekend programs such as recreational, educational, and cultural activities (the “Services”) at the Center at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the Agreement was for three years commencing on September 2, 2009, and included an additional two year renewal option by mutual consent of the Parties; and

WHEREAS, the initial three year term will expire on September 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs has issued a 90 day extension while the parties exercise the renewal option: and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs has reviewed and is satisfied with EACK’s performance under the Agreement and desires that the Agreement be extended for two years; and

WHEREAS, EACK desires to continue to provide the Services at the Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor or his designee, on behalf of the City, is hereby authorized to enter into a renewal to the Agreement with EAKC. to continue providing the Services at the Center at no cost to the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that to the extent EACK is donating time and resources to the City, the City hereby accepts such donation.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney, or his designee is hereby authorized to prepare the renewal for execution by the Mayor.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the renewal shall not become binding on the City, and the City shall incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney, and delivered to East Atlanta Kids Club, Inc.
