**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT, PURSUANT TO 2-1602 OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES, UTILIZING GSA CONTRACT #GS-07F-0416M, TO PURCHASE TACTICAL PROTECTIVE GEAR, FROM DIAMONDBACK TACTICAL, TO PROTECT ATLANTA POLICE OFFICERS ENGAGED IN HIGH RISK POLICE OPERATIONS, ON BEHALF OF THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT ("DEPARTMENT"), IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS AND TWENTY-ONE CENTS (\$324,770.21). ALL COSTS SHALL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM THE FEDERAL RICO TRUST FUND 7701 (TRUST FUND); 240101 (APD CHIEF OF POLICE); 5316001 (EQUIPMENT, \$1,000 - \$4,999); 1320000 (CHIEF EXECUTIVE); 600234 (FEDERAL-RICO); 69999 (FUNDING SOURCE FOR NON-CAPITAL TRUST PROJECTS); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Atlanta Police Department ("Department") must regularly carry out warrants at suspected illegal syndicate locations and other high risk police operations that require Atlanta Police officers to confront heavily armed suspects; and

**WHEREAS**, the proper use of tactical protective gear during these high risk police operations greatly reduces the risk of injury and death to Atlanta Police officers from gunfire from the heavily armed suspects; and

**WHEREAS**, the effectiveness of tactical protective gear diminishes over time and must periodically be replaced to ensure that it functions correctly; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has determined that it has a substantial amount of tactical protective gear in need of replacement to ensure the best possible protection for its police officers while they are engaged in the execution of warrants at the locations of suspected illegal syndicates and other high risk police operations; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City's Procurement and Real Estate Code of Ordinances 2-1602, the Chief Procurement Officer may procure supplies, services and construction items through contracts established by public procurement units where such contracts and contractors substantially meet the requirements of the city's Procurement and Real Estate Code; and

**WHEREAS**, The United States General Services Administration ("GSA") contract #GS-07F-0416M was competitively procured in a manner consistent with Division 4 of the City's Procurement and Real Estate Code, and the costs of the goods and/or services are comparable; and



**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend entering into a cooperative purchasing agreement utilizing GSA contract #GS-07F-0416M, to purchase tactical protective gear from Armor Express, for the Atlanta Police Department, to protect Atlanta Police officers from gunfire while carrying out high risk police operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has identified as the funding source for the tactical protective gear, the amount of three hundred twenty-four thousand, seven hundred seventy dollars and twenty-one cents (\$324,770.21) from the Federal RICO Trust Fund: 7701 (Trust Fund); 240101 (APD Chief of Police); 5316001 (Equipment, \$1,000 - \$4,999); 1320000 (Chief Executive); 600234 (Federal RICO); 69999 (Funding Source for Non-Capital Trust Projects).


**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES** that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized, pursuant to 2-1602 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances, to enter into a cooperative purchasing agreement, utilizing the United States General Services Administration ("GSA") contract #GS-07F-0416M, to procure tactical protective gear from Diamondback Tactical, on behalf of the Atlanta Police Department, to protect Atlanta Police officers from gunfire while carrying out high risk police operations, in an amount not to exceed three hundred twenty-four thousand, seven hundred seventy dollars and twenty-one cents (\$324,770.21).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, all costs for the tactical protective gear shall be charged to and paid from the Federal RICO Trust Fund: Federal RICO Trust Fund: 7701 (Trust Fund); 240101 (APD Chief of Police); 5316001 (Equipment, \$1,000 - \$4,999); 1320000 (Chief Executive); 600234 (Federal RICO); 69999 (Funding Source for Non-Capital Trust Projects).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Chief Procurement Officer is directed to prepare an appropriate purchase order.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the purchase order will not become binding upon the City and the City shall incur no obligation or liability until it has been approved by the Chief Procurement Officer.
