A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE PEACHTREE CREEK SOUTH FORK RELIEF STORAGE AND PUMPING STATION TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING THE CITY IN REVIEWING PROPOSED DESIGN AND SCOPE OF WORK TO ENSURE THE USE OF BEST PRACTICES FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND STORAGE TANKS ARE BEING USED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta operates several Water Reclamation Facilities for the purpose of cleaning its waste and storm water for deposit back into the Chattahoochee River and other tributaries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta is presently undertaking the task of designing and preparing for bid the project known as the Peachtree Creek South Fork Relief Storage and Pumping Station; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta and its ratepayers are interested in seeing that this project is accomplished using best practices and value engineering that will it is done in a timely, cost-effective and efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the storage tank can store flow from many sewer connections and will reduce overflows to the river and other tributaries in the region; and

WHEREAS, the impacted neighborhoods and its elected officials where this storage tank will be constructed want to be involved in the design and construction of the facility to ensure that all community concerns are addressed; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Atlanta are keenly aware of the problems the city faces with its Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) as mandated by the Clean Water Act, Safe Drinking Water Act and the 1998-9 Consent Decree Orders; and desires that this project remain on schedule and for this reason establishes a Technical Advisory Committee for the Peachtree Creek South Fork Relief Storage and Pumping Station Project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA; as follows

SECTION 1: That a Technical Advisory Committee for the Peachtree Creek South Fork Relief Storage and Pumping Station Project is hereby established effective upon approval of the mayor and council.



SECTION 2: That a Technical Advisory Committee for the Peachtree Creek South Fork Relief Storage and Pumping Station Project shall consist of the following members:

- One representative* from each of the Piedmont Heights, Morningside/Lenox Park and Lindridge/Martin Manor neighborhood associations
- One (1) representative* for the Cheshire Bridge business owners
- A representative of NPU-F
- One (1) member appointed each by the Councilmember of District 6 and Post 2-at-Large
- City Utilities Committee Chair or her designee
- Commissioner of Watershed Management or her designee

*** Neighborhood representatives are encouraged to have technical expertise or background related to the project (e.g., civil engineering, environmental engineering, etc.)**

SECTION 3: The Technical Advisory Committee shall meet and submit a written report to the Council's City Utilities Committee on a monthly basis until the project has been completed. At each of the committee's monthly meetings, the Department of Watershed Management shall update members on the overall status of the project, including but not limited to any changes in project scope, construction timeline, other significant project modifications under consideration, etc.

SECTION 4: The Technical Advisory Committee shall convene for its first meeting no later than sixty (60) days after being established by this action.

SECTION 5: The Municipal Clerk is directed to send (via e-mail, fax or Priority Mail) a copy of this resolution to all members.

SECTION 6: That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
