A RESOLUTION REAUTHORIZING THE REEMPLOYMENT OF DAN BOOZER IN THE POSITION OF CONSULTANT IN THE OFFICE OF CITY COUNCIL MEMBER CLETA M. WINSLOW FOR AN HOURLY COMPENSATION NOT TO EXCEED \$900 PER MONTH PURSUANT TO SECTION 3-505 (c) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Council Member Winslow has made use of federal grants to improve public safety and the quality of life in Council District 4 supplementing activities funded by the City of Atlanta's General Fund Budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-505 (c)(1) of the City Charter authorizes the reemployment of a retired employee for a period nor to exceed 520 business days; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-505(c)(3) of the City Charter also requires that a period of reemployment shall not exceed 120 business days without reauthorization by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Boozer has provided invaluable expertise in Council Member Winslow's Office on a part time basis, applying for multiple state and federal grants and securing funds for gang prevention and youth programs at the Centers of Hope in the City; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Winslow wishes to continue the reemployment of Mr. Boozer on the same part time work schedule to complete grantor required reports for existing grants and seek additional grants for youth programs, historic preservation and tourism promotion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Office of Council Member Cleta M. Winslow is hereby authorized to continue the reemployment of Dan Boozer, a retired employee of the City of Atlanta for a period not to exceed 375 business days for compensation not to exceed \$900 per month, as provided by Section 3-505 (c) of the City Charter. As provided in Charter Section 3-505 (c)(3), the reemployment of Mr. Boozer shall be subject to reauthorization by the City Council upon Mr. Boozer having provided his employment services for a period of 120 additional business days.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that payment to Mr. Boozer for services rendered shall be charged to and paid from: 1001.030204.1110000 General Fund Council District 04 Council Members Expense.
