

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta's ("City") the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs ("DRPCA") requires computer lab furniture for use by patrons of its Office of Recreation and the Office of Cultural Affairs; and

WHEREAS, DRPCA desires to purchase approximately three hundred tables and nine hundred chairs to better provide adequate furniture needs to support the recreation and cultural center computer labs servicing the City and the greater Atlanta area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-1601 et seq. of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances, the Chief Procurement Officer may procure supplies, services or construction items through contracts established by a public procurement unit where such contracts and contractors substantially meet the requirements of Article X of the Atlanta Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of DPRCA and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend utilizing the State of Georgia Contract #SWC60748 for the purchase of office furniture in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$350,000.00) from the Contractors; and

WHEREAS, this cooperative agreement was competitively procured in a manner consistent with the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor, or his designee, on behalf of the City is authorized to enter into cooperative purchasing agreement number COA-6446-PL with the Contractors utilizing State of Georgia Contract #SWC60748 for the purchase of office furniture in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$350,000.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all contracted work will be charged to and paid from:
