A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (“MOU”) AGREEMENT WITH FULTON COUNTY, DEPARTMENT OF FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DRIVE, S.W. AND ADAMSVILLE PLACE PARKWAY, S.W.; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Fulton County, Department of Facilities and Transportation Services (“County”) desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding Agreement with the City of Atlanta (“City”) to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, S.W. and Adamsville Place Parkway, S.W. attached hereto as Exhibit “A”; and

WHEREAS, the installation of a traffic signal at this location will improve pedestrian mobility and access to transit; and

WHEREAS, the County will obtain all necessary permits for the installation through coordination with the Georgia Department of Transportation, and will provide the signal warrant study and prepare the project design; and

WHEREAS, the City and County will each contribute 50% of the construction costs for the signal project, with the City’s costs not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$150,000.00); and

WHEREAS, once Fulton County, Department of Facilities and Transportation Services has completed the operational testing period, the City of Atlanta will be responsible for the operations and maintenance of this signal.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor, or his Designee, is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Fulton County, Department of Facilities and Transportation Services for the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, S.W. and Adamsville Place Parkway, S.W.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to negotiate, prepare and review an appropriate Memorandum of Understanding Agreement for execution by the Mayor and Fulton County.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Memorandum of Understanding Agreement will not become binding upon the City, and the City will incur no obligation or liability



under it until the Agreement is approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to Fulton County.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(MOU)-Exhibit-1

between the
Fulton County Government – Department of Facilities and Transportation Services
(hereafter the COUNTY)
and
City of Atlanta (hereinafter called the CITY)

Whereas the COUNTY proposes to undertake a project to provide a traffic signal at the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr Boulevard and Adamsville Parkway located in the City of Atlanta by contract through competitive bidding, and:

Whereas the COUNTY will obtain all necessary permits for the installation through coordination with Georgia Department of Transportation, and address the Signal Warrant Study and prepare the project design, and:


Whereas the CITY and the COUNTY will each contribute 50% of the construction cost for the signal project, and:

Whereas the COUNTY will be responsible for the construction of the project, and the CITY will participate in the Signal Inspection during construction, and:

Whereas the CITY will be responsible for the operations and maintenance of this signal after the 30 day burn; and, now therefore:

The following is hereby mutually agreed to and understood by both parties:

1. The preliminary engineering, including preparation of detailed plans for the required traffic signal installation will be accomplished by the COUNTY or COUNTY'S Consultant, the cost of which will be the responsibility of the COUNTY. The plans shall provide for new installation of a traffic signal. The COUNTY shall provide plans in Micro station file format, and, blue-line plan sheets.
2. The COUNTY or its Consultant shall prepare all necessary documents for the acquisition of temporary and permanent easements or required right of way; and provide services to acquire said easements and right of way; and shall certify possession in accordance with the State Department of Transportation requirements.
3. All work necessary for the construction, operations and maintenance of the traffic signal installation shall be in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control



Devices. The final plans when approved shall be included in the contract and let to bid by the COUNTY.

4. All construction (layout, inspection) and contract supervision shall be the responsibility of the COUNTY and the COUNTY'S contractor shall be responsible to assure that all work is accomplished in accordance with plans and specifications as required by MUTCD standards. Engineering for plan revisions for the OWNER'S facilities shall be the responsibility of the OWNER and OWNER'S Consultant.
5. Inspection and final acceptance of the project shall be the responsibility of the CITY.
6. The CITY will become the sole and complete OWNER of the Traffic Signal and shall have the right to visit and inspect the work at any time and address all problems or any observed discrepancies or potential problems.
7. The COUNTY and CITY agree that all matters will be governed by the Georgia Department of Transportation for safety of the Traffic Signal Maintenance on Martin Luther King Boulevard.
