AN AMENDED RESOLUTION BY FINANCE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS TO EXECUTE TEMPORARY SERVICE CONTRACTS WITH RETIRED CITY OF ATLANTA ("CITY") POLICE OFFICERS AT THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT AND BELOW FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING CONTINUING PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT ("APD"); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") desires to provide continuity of services public safety services; and

WHEREAS, retired APD police officers possess knowledge and expertise to provide necessary services;

WHEREAS, such engagements are authorized pursuant to Article 3, Chapter 5, Section 3-505 of the Charter of Atlanta.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: "That the Mayor or his designee be and is hereby authorized to enter into Re-Employment Agreements to reengage retired APD police officers at the rank of Lieutenant and below at the individual's last held salary without benefits. Re-Employment Agreements will be for a period of one year, to be renewed annually, and will not exceed a total of three (3) years re-employment. Such individuals selected must complete an application process, submit to annual physicals and adhere to all employment policies of the City.


SECTION 2: The Re-Employment Initiative authorized by this resolution is available only to those eligible retirees in Fiscal Years 2014 and 2015.

SECTION 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is directed to prepare appropriate agreements for execution by the Mayor or his designee to reengage such individuals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the contractual agreements will not become binding upon the City and the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor or his designee and delivered to the respective retired City of Atlanta police officer.
