

As we continue to garner a community driven process, our appointment is made on the condition that the representative appointee of NPU-V continues to be an active participant of NPU-V during his appointment on this task force. We also require that our appointee reports to NPU-V no less than quarterly, once every 3-months in regards to the matters which affects the neighborhoods of NPU-V and to have an open and transparent dialogue with the officers of NPU-V Atlanta and its members as matters arise in regards to development. In addition, as various neighborhoods border or are adjacent to Downtown Atlanta including Adair Park, Pittsburgh, Mechanicsville, Capital Gateway and Summerhill, the representative appointee to the DDTAG will attend their meetings as requested when matters affect their boundaries. Lastly, in accordance with participation as similarly as an officer, the appointee may be removed for non-attendance at four (4) regular meetings during a calendar year or for non-attendance at three (3) consecutive regular meetings, without advance notification from the President or at the discretion of the NPU-V membership and a new appointee named in accordance with the NPU-V bylaws.
