


Mr. Brian McGowan (Bio)

Brian McGowan is the President/CEO of Invest Atlanta - the economic development arm of the City of Atlanta. Prior to this he was appointed by President Barack Obama as U.S. Deputy Assistant Secretary of Commerce in September 2009. In this capacity he served as the Chief Operating Officer of the U.S. Economic Development Administration and was appointed as a U.S. delegate to the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development in Paris, France. McGowan was also detailed to the White House as a Senior Economic Advisor to the President on the BP oil Spill where he led a federal inter-agency Economic Solutions Team in the National Incident Command.

Before joining the Obama Administration he served as California's Deputy Secretary for Economic Development and Commerce where he oversaw the State's economic development programs. He was appointed by Governor Schwarzenegger in January of 2008.

McGowan has 18 years of economic development experience at all levels of government. Prior to his appointment, McGowan was appointed by the Board of Supervisors as the Economic Development Agency Administrator for the County of San Bernardino and worked for the City of Ontario and the City of Palm Springs. He was also a consultant for the US Agency for International Development where he developed economic growth programs for cities in Bulgaria and Serbia.

McGowan was recently appointed by Governor Deal to serve as a Board member for the McPherson Redevelopment Authority. He also serves as a Board member for the Georgia Foreign Trade Zone and the International Economic Development Council.

Brian received a Bachelor's degree in Political Science from the University of California, Riverside and a Master's degree in Politics, Economics and Business from the Claremont Graduate University. He is also the Michael and Mary Johnston Fellow at the Claremont Graduate University where he is completing a PhD in American Politics and Policy.
