AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRIBUTION OF \$1,500.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 8 COUNCIL OFFICE FUNDS TO THE GA CONSERVANCY TO PAY FOR STAFFING NEEDS RELATED TO THE COLLIER VILLAGE BLUEPRINTS PLAN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in 2008 the Collier Village Blueprints Plan was put together through the Georgia Conservancy's Blueprints Plan program with the participation and input of NPU C, and representatives from the neighborhoods within and surrounding the boundaries of the plan, which included the Wildwood, Springlake, Channing Valley and Underwood Hills neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the plan evaluated the predominantly commercial district in northwest Atlanta defined by the triangle formed by I-75, Howell Mill Road and Collier Road, and

WHEREAS, the plan was used to develop and recommend transportation, land use and urban design and environment strategies for the future redevelopment of the largely commercial area; and

WHEREAS, even though the plan was vetted through the community at the time, it was not fully evaluated by the City's Planning Staff, nor has it gone through a formal public meeting or hearing process, and therefore has yet to come before the Council for consideration of adoption into the City's Comprehensive Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, since the Georgia Conservancy sponsored the development of the plan and can provide staffing needs in regards to updating the plan and guiding it through the public meeting process, their services are needed to help in order to get the plan to the point that it can be considered for adoption into the CDP.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:


SECTION 1: That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to remit payment to the Georgia Conservancy in the amount of \$1,500.00 to cover staffing needs related to updating the Collier Village Blueprints Plan and guiding it through the public meeting process.

SECTION 2: That all payments shall be charged to and made from the following:
