MAYOR'S ACTION

AN ORDINANCE BY

COUNCIL MEMBER MICHAEL JULIAN BOND

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO CREATE A TRUST FUND ACCOUNT FOR TAX REVENUE COLLECTED FROM SUNDAY RETAIL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR SALES; AMENDING THE 2012 (GENERAL FUND) BUDGET BY ADDING TO ANTICIPATIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS SALES TAX PROCEEDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00; TO USE SAID TAX REVENUE FOR ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT DUI ENFORCEMENT AND FOR ENFORCEMENT OF CITY OF ATLANTA LIQUOR LICENSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, On November 8, 2011, the citizens of the City of Atlanta voted to allow Sunday retail sales of beer, wine and liquor; and

WHEREAS, The retail sales of beer, wine and liquor will commence in the City of Atlanta on January 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, It is anticipated that the revenue collected from ^(SUNDAY ONLY) retail sales tax of beer, wine and liquor for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2012 will be \$250,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, It is anticipated that the revenue collected from retail sales tax of beer, wine and liquor for Fiscal Year 2013 will be \$500,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, The Atlanta Police Department DUI and License and Permits Units are integral to protecting the health, welfare and public safety of communities, residents and visitors; and,

WHEREAS, Creating a trust fund specifically for these APD Units will provide an opportunity for much needed enforcement in areas that have been neglected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: To authorize the Chief Financial Officer to create a trust fund account for tax revenue collected from Sunday retail beer, wine and liquor sales.

SECTION 2: To amend the FY 2012 (General Fund) Budget by adding to anticipations and appropriations sales tax proceeds in the amount of \$250,000.00.

SECTION 3: To utilize said tax revenue to fund increased enforcement for Atlanta Police Department DUI and Liquor License enforcement.

SECTION 4: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed for purposes of this ordinance only, and only to the extent of the conflict.
