


AN ORDINANCE BY COUNCILMEMBER MICHAEL JULIAN BOND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO NEGOTIATE FOR AND TO PURCHASE APPROXIMATELY .1836 ACRES LOCATED AT 38-42 JOSEPH E. LOWERY BOULEVARD, SW FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING ELLA MAE BRAYBOY PARK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 10-R-1731, adopted October 4, 2010 and approved October 12, 2010, a Commission was created to determine an appropriate honor memorializing the life and work of Ella Mae Brayboy; and,

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2013 the City Council adopted 13-R-0642, and which was subsequently approved by the Mayor, accepting the recommendations made by the Commission to Honor Ella Mae Brayboy; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission to Honor Ella Mae Brayboy met, discussed, and deliberated with regard to such an appropriate honor; and,

WHEREAS, the establishment of such a park will assist in promoting and celebrating the life of Ella May Brayboy, a proponent of civic engagement and political participation and a representation of female leadership during the Modern Civil Rights Movement; and,

WHEREAS, this location will also promote the historical legacies within the surrounding historic Washington Park community; and,

WHEREAS, the establishment of this public park will serve to beautify the community and provide additional green space within this highly concentrated community of historic structures and public art; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: The Mayor or his designee is authorized, on behalf of the City, to negotiate for and purchase approximately .1836 acres located at 38-42 Joseph E. Lowery Boulevard, SW for the purpose of creating Ella Mae Brayboy Park.

Section 2: The Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Department of Public Works, Office of Planning and Urban Design Commission are authorized to identify funding and to establish said park.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.

A RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION TO HONOR MRS. ELLA MAE BRAYBOY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 10-R-1731, adopted October 4, 2010 and approved October 12, 2010, a Commission was created to determine an appropriate honor memorializing the life and work of Mrs. Ella Mae Brayboy; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has met, discussed, and deliberated with regard to such an appropriate honor; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has made its recommendations which are now being presented to the Atlanta City Council (the report on the Commission is attached as an exhibit to this resolution).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: The Commission has made the following recommendations for an appropriate honor memorializing the life of Mrs. Ella Mae Brayboy; and for other purposes.

For Members of the Atlanta City Council to negotiate for and to purchase the properties located at 38-42 Joseph E. Lowery Blvd. SW from the current land owners for the purpose of creating a new park to honor of Mrs. Ella Mae Brayboy.

- The establishment of such a park will assist in promoting and celebrating the life of Mrs. Ella May Brayboy, a proponent of civic engagement and political participation and a representation of female leadership during the Modern Civil Rights Movement.
- This location will also promote the historical legacies within the surrounding communities of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive and Joseph E. Lowery Drive intersection.

Placement of a Historic Marker in honor of Mrs. Ella Mae Brayboy

- To erect a historic marker at the site of the proposed park at 38-42 Joseph E Lowery Blvd., SW.

Maximize the potential use of green space

Section 2: The City Council of the City of Atlanta hereby accepts said recommendations, will review and consider them, and will take appropriate action consistent with the spirit of the process, in bestowing a fitting honor to the memory of the Committee on the Appeal for Human Rights and the Atlanta Student Movement

Section 3: All resolutions or part of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
