A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO CORRECT THE DISPLAY OF THE AMERICAN FLAG SIGN AT THE I-75 EXIT TO ANDREW YOUNG INTERNATIONAL BOULEVARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, members of the Atlanta City Council did request via Resolution 13-R-3734 that the Mayor or his designee (Department of Public Works) review whether the replica of the American Flag at the I-75 exit on to Andrew Young International Boulevard is displayed correctly ; and

WHEREAS, members from the American Legion Post 233 in Loganville Georgia did appear before the City Utilities Committee to address the correctness of the current display of the flag at this location; and

WHEREAS, the members of this organization did express to the committee that the flag on the sign as currently displayed is done so inappropriately; and

WHEREAS, this legislation will correct what some are viewing as an obvious error and make the necessary correction that will satisfy past and present members of the military, members of the American Legion and the American people.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA; as follows:

That the Mayor or his designee (Department of Public Works) have the flag signat the I-75 exit on to Andrew Young International Boulevard corrected with the union (stars) being displayed in the uppermost and to the flag's own right, that is, to the observer's left (see Attachment Item #8).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED if the Municipal Clerk is directed to send (fax or Priority Mail) a copy of this resolution to the American Legion Post 233 in Loganville, GA 30052.

AND FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED that all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed for purposes of this resolution, and only to the extent of the conflict.

How to Display the Flag

1. When the flag is displayed over the middle of the street, it should be suspended vertically with the union to the north in an east and west street or to the east in a north and south street.



2. The flag of the United States of America, when it is displayed with another flag against a wall from crossed staffs, should be on the right, the flag's own right [that means the viewer's left --Webmaster], and its staff should be in front of the staff of the other flag.



3. The flag, when flown at half-staff, should be first hoisted to the peak for an instant and then lowered to the half-staff position. The flag should be again raised to the peak before it is lowered for the day. By "half-staff" is meant lowering the flag to one-half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff. Crepe streamers may be affixed to spear heads or flagstuffs in a parade only by order of the President of the United States.



4. When flags of States, cities, or localities, or pennants of societies are flown on the same halyard with the flag of the United States, the latter should always be at the peak. When the flags are flown from adjacent staffs, the flag of the United States should be hoisted first and lowered last. No such flag or pennant may be placed above the flag of the United States or to the right of the flag of the United States (the viewer's left). When the flag is half-masted, both flags are half-masted, with the US flag at the mid-point and the other flag below.




5. When the flag is suspended over a sidewalk from a rope extending from a house to a pole at the edge of the sidewalk, the flag should be hoisted out, union first, from the building.



6. When the flag of the United States is displayed from a staff projecting horizontally or at an angle from the window sill, balcony, or front of a building, the union of the flag should be placed at the peak of the staff unless the flag is at half-staff.



7. When the flag is used to cover a casket, it should be so placed that the union is at the head and over the left shoulder. The flag should not be lowered into the grave or allowed to touch the ground.



8. When the flag is displayed in a manner other than by being flown from a staff, it should be displayed flat, whether indoors or out. When displayed either horizontally or vertically against a wall, the union should be uppermost and to the flag's own right, that is, to the observer's left. When displayed in a window it should be displayed in the same way, that
