

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO INSTALL SIGNAGE PROHIBITING VEHICLES EXCEEDING FOUR (4) TONS ON RIDGEWOOD ROAD, NE AND MARLBROOK DRIVE, NE ~~FROM ENTERING THE FRAZER CENTER FROM THIS DIRECTION~~; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, there has been community (Lake Claire) discussion on prohibiting MARTA Mobility buses from entering the Frazer Center via Ridgewood Road, NE and Marlbrook Drive, NE and route them toward the entrance from Ponce de Leon, Drive, NE; and

**WHEREAS**, the rerouting of MARTA Mobility buses into the Lake Claire community is causing a public safety concern for the community; and

**WHEREAS**, recent traffic studies of the area indicate that the growth of the Frazer Center is responsible for the significant increase in traffic volume; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens that once lived in a quiet residential area without sidewalks are now inundated with a significant amount of auto and bus traffic which poses significant public safety risk for the residents.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA** as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the Mayor or his designee (Commissioner of Public Works) install signage prohibiting vehicles in excess of four (4) tons from entering the Frazer Center via Ridgewood Road, NE and Marlbrook Drive, NE.

**SECTION 2:** That these signs will be installed ninety (90) days after adoption and approval by the City Council and the Mayor.

**SECTION 3:** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby waived in this instance only.
