A RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO ACCEPT MONETARY AND IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF PLAQUES AND/OR STATUARY HONORING FIRE STATION #16 AND THE CITY OF ATLANTA'S FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN FIREFIGHTERS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO CREATE A TRUST FUND ACCOUNT ON BEHALF OF THE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT FOR THE DEPOSIT OF MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF ATLANTA IN CONNECTION WITH THE COMMEMORATION OF FIRE STATION #16 AND THE CITY OF ATLANTA'S FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN FIRE FIGHTERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, 12-R-1814 was adopted by the Full City Council on October 4, 2010 and approved by the Mayor on October 12, 2010; and

WHEREAS, to honor Fire Station #16 and the City of Atlanta's first African-American firefighters, it is the intent of the City of Atlanta to work with private donors to purchase and install plaques and/or statuary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: The City of Atlanta is hereby authorized to accept monetary and in-kind contributions for the purchase and installation of plaques and/or statuary to commemorate Fire Station #16 and the City of Atlanta's first African-American firefighters; and,

SECTION 2: The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to create a Trust Fund account on behalf of the Fire Rescue Department for the deposit of monetary contributions received by the City of Atlanta in connection with the commemoration of Fire Station #16 and the City of Atlanta's first African-American firefighters as described above.

SECTION 3: The created trust fund account shall remain in effect until terminated by action of the Atlanta City Council.

SECTION 4: That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
