


AN ORDINANCE BY

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO MAKE THE INTERSECTION OF IRWIN STREET, SAMPSON STREET AND AUBURN AVENUE AN ALL WAY STOP IN THE INMAN PARK AND OLD FOURTH WARD COMMUNITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the citizens in the Inman Park and Old Fourth Ward communities have made it known to their elected representatives that pedestrians lives and the potential for vehicular accidents due to limited sight distances at the intersection of Irwin Street, Sampson Street and Auburn Avenue; and

WHEREAS, more motorists are traveling to this area because of the popularity of the restaurants and small businesses along with the increased population of the Inman Park and Old Fourth Ward communities; and

WHEREAS, the streets within the Inman Park and Old Fourth Ward communities are narrow and have limited sight distances further exacerbating the community's traffic problems; and

WHEREAS, the traffic flow from old and new businesses, the recent opening of the Eastside Trail of the Atlanta Beltline, and the increase in the residential population in the Inman Park and Old Fourth Ward communities over the past decade; and

WHEREAS, the Inman Park and Old Fourth Ward communities is waiting on a pending study for this corridor; and

WHEREAS, the public's safety would be greatly enhanced now if All Way Stops were installed at the intersection of Irwin Street, Sampson Street and Auburn Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA; as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor or his designee (Office of Traffic and Transportation) is directed to make the intersection of Irwin Street, Sampson Street and Auburn Avenue an All Way Stop.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby waived in this instance only.
