**ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE BY COUNCILMEMBER YOLANDA ADREAN TO INSTALL ALL-WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF WOODWARD WAY AND DELLWOOD DRIVE, NW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the residents and property owners of the area surrounding the intersection of Woodward Way and Dellwood Drive, NW and the Peachtree Battle Alliance, which represents the neighborhood, desires that the current 2-way stop signs at said intersection be expanded to a 4-way stop; and

WHEREAS, with the presence of the Bobby Jones Golf Course and the proximity of the intersection from Northside Drive, there is a considerable amount of cut-through traffic; and

WHEREAS, the residents in the area believe that both vehicular and pedestrian traffic are at risk without the installation of a 4-way stop at the intersection; and

WHEREAS, despite the intersection not meeting technical warrants during a recent study that was conducted during a holiday weekend during which traffic flow was lighter than usual, the neighborhood and surrounding residents strongly believe the expansion of the intersection to a 4-way stop would greatly improve the safety of drivers and pedestrians traveling through the intersection.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to install all-way stop signs at the intersection of Woodward Way and Dellwood Drive, NW.

Section 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same be hereby waived in this instance only.
