


AN ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE ARTICLE X, PROCUREMENT AND REAL ESTATE CODE, OF THE ATLANTA CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO EXTEND MASTER TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT NUMBER FC-5137 WITH NORTHROP GRUMMAN SYSTEMS CORPORATION FOR CRITICAL SAFETY SYSTEMS SUPPORT SERVICES TO CONTINUE ON A MONTH-TO-MONTH BASIS FOR A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN THREE (3) MONTHS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND THIRTY-THREE CENTS (\$177,823.33) PER MONTH, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA'S POLICE DEPARTMENT, FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT, AND DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, ALL CONTRACTED WORK TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM THE FUNDING NUMBERS LISTED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation ("Northrop Grumman") provides application and hardware maintenance support ("maintenance support") for the City of Atlanta ("City") City's critical public safety information systems support on a 24 x 7 x 365 basis; and

**WHEREAS**, these critical safety systems applications and associated hardware include the City's E-911 Center Support Computer Aided Dispatch ("CAD") System, Atlanta Police Department ("APD") Record Management System ("RMS"), Atlanta Fire Rescue ("AFR") RMS, and AFR & APD Mobile Data Computing ("MDC") units; and

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into multi-term Master Technology Agreement Number FC-5137, Critical Safety Systems Support ("Master Technology Agreement Number FC-5137") with Northrop Grumman, pursuant to Resolution 10-O-0946, adopted by Atlanta City Council ("Council") on June 21, 2010, and approved by the Mayor on June 29, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the City was authorized to exercise renewal option number one (1) for Master Technology Agreement Number FC-5137, pursuant to Resolution 11-R-0754, adopted by Council on May 16, 2011, and approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on May 25, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the City was then authorized to exercise renewal option number two (2) for Master Technology Agreement Number FC-5137, pursuant to Resolution 12-R-0826, adopted by Council on June 18, 2012, and approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 June 27, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Procurement Officer authorized a ninety (90) day extension for Master Technology Agreement Number FC-5137 with Northrop Grumman beginning July 1, 2013 and ending September 28, 2013, pursuant to Article X, Division 4, Section 2-1206(a) of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances ("Code"); and

**WHEREAS,** Master Technology Agreement number FC-5137 with Northrop Grumman for maintenance support of the City's critical safety systems applications and hardware will expire on September 28, 2013, before DIT can present the Council with legislation to authorize a new, publicly solicited contract for said services; and

**WHEREAS,** the Chief Procurement Officer is not authorized to issue another extension but the critical safety systems listed above must continue to operate without interruption.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1:** That Article X, Procurement and Real Estate Code, of the Atlanta City Code of Ordinances is waived to authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to extend Master Technology Agreement number FC-5137 with Northrop Grumman for maintenance of the City's critical safety systems support applications and hardware for an amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars And Thirty-Three Cents (\$177,823.33) per month.

**SECTION 2:** That the extension shall not commence until September 29, 2013, and will continue on a month-to-month basis until the earlier of either the execution of a new, publicly solicited, critical safety systems support contract, or no more than three (3) months.

**SECTION 3:** That all month-to-month contracted work shall be charged to and paid from the following Fund, Department Organization, Account, and Function Activity ("FDOA") and for other purposes: 2151 (EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FUND) 240207 (APD E911) 5213001 (CONSULTING/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES — TECHNICAL) 3800000 (E911).

**SECTION 4:** That the Chief Procurement Officer or his designee, in consultation with the City Attorney or her designee, is directed to prepare an amendment to extend the current term of Master Technology Agreement number FC-5137 on a month-to-month basis for the purchase of critical safety systems support services.

**SECTION 5:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, including but not limited to Section 2-1212 (Encumbrances required for contracts) and Section 2-1187 (Methods of source selection), et seq. of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances, are waived for this instance only.
