A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE CITY OF ATLANTA DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP (DDTAG), FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A COMPREHENSIVE MASTER PLAN FOR DOWNTOWN ATLANTA, AND TO RESEARCH AND IDENTIFY FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR DOWNTOWN ATLANTA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, Downtown Atlanta has lagged behind Midtown, Buckhead and other areas of metro Atlanta with regards to economic development; and

**WHEREAS**, Properties like the Underground and surrounding areas have underperformed in providing residents and tourist comfortable options for entertainment and living; and

**WHEREAS**, Strengthening Downtown's image and economic standing will have positive impact on the city as a whole; and

**WHEREAS**, There are several major projects planned for Downtown, including: The National Civil Rights Museum, College Hall of Fame, Multi Modal Passenger Terminal (MMPT), New Falcons Stadium, and Turner Field Redevelopment; and

**WHEREAS**, It is important to create continuity within these projects to catalyze further economic development and growth downtown; and

**WHEREAS**, It is also important to identify creative ways to secure funding to encourage private investment downtown; and

**WHEREAS**, It is recommended that DDTAG be established to undertake this task.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:**

**Section 1:** The Downtown Development Technical Advisory Group (DDTAG) is hereby established.

**Section 2:** DDTAG shall consist of <sup>26</sup> members as follows:



- Five members (Community Representatives) appointed by Mayor
- Two member (Community Representative) appointed by Council President
- Chair of Community Development/Human Resources Committee
- Two Councilmembers appointed by Mayor
- Invest Atlanta President or his designee
- MARTA GM, or his designee
- CAP President, or his designee
- GSU President, or his designee
- One representative from Downtown Neighborhood Association
- One representatives appointed by Councilmembers from District 1, 2, 3, 4 and Post 1
- One representatives appointed by Councilmembers from District 5, 6, 7, 8 and Post 2
- One representatives appointed by Councilmembers from District 9, 10, 11, 12 and Post 3
- One Representative from NPU M
- One Representative from NPU V
- One Representative from NPU L
- One Representative from Metro Atlanta Chamber of Commerce
- One Representative from Atlanta Planning Advisory Board (APAB)
- Atlanta Housing Authority president and CEO or her designee
- Executive Director of Georgia World congress Center, or his designee
- Executive director of Georgia Building Authority, or his designee

The office of the Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to notify the above individuals and organizations to request that the names of their nominees be submitted to the Office of Municipal Clerk

**Section 3:** All members shall be confirmed by the city council

**Section 4:** DDTAG shall have at least six work sessions, including at least two (2) public hearings. One (1) public hearing to solicit public input prior to development of Master plan. The second public hearing to make comments and recommendations on the first draft of the Master Plan.

**Section 5:** DDTAG shall submit a report and final master plan six (6) months following the enactment of this resolution

**Sections 6:** The City shall commit no more than five hundred thousand dollars to develop a downtown master plan.

**Section 7:** All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict are hereby rescinded
