

**A RESOLUTION BY
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT / HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF WOOD GYM FLOORING, BLEACHERS, BACKBOARDS, WALL PADDING, CHAIRS AND SPORTS EQUIPMENT, IN ADDITION TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FROM THE NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (“NCAA”) VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$150,000.00) FOR USE AT CITY OF ATLANTA RECREATION CENTERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs (“DPRCA”) provides a number of amenities and recreational programs to City of Atlanta (“City”) residents on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Centers of Hope, a program implemented by Mayor Kasim Reed, the City is invested in providing a comprehensive network of high quality programming and facilities for its youth to help achieve excellence and healthy lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, numerous individuals, organizations and corporations share the City’s desire to support youth and wish to contribute to the City’s Centers of Hope; and

WHEREAS, the National Collegiate Athletic Association (“NCAA”) is an association of over 1,200 members serving the student-athlete and provides community programs in each of its tournament host cities, and hosting its 75th anniversary of the Final Four Tournament in Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the NCAA approached the City with a proposal to donate wood flooring for one gym court, bleachers, backboards, wall padding, chairs, sports equipment, and professional installation services valued at approximately One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$150,000.00) at Dunbar and Peachtree Hills Recreation Centers; and

WHEREAS, the City would greatly benefit from this donation and is appreciative of the generosity of the NCAA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor, on behalf of the City, is authorized to accept the donation of wood gym flooring, bleachers, backboards, wall padding, chairs, sports equipment, and professional installation services from the National Collegiate Athletic Association valued at approximately One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$150,000.00).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that to the extent that the NCAA is donating time and resources to the City, the City hereby accepts the donation.
