A RESOLUTION BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE WHITE HOUSE OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY (“ONDCP”), IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE-MILLION, TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, THREE-HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$5,277,325), FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISRUPTING AND DISMANTLING ILLEGAL DRUG TRAFFICKING ORGANIZATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (“ONDCP”) offers grant funds to High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (“HIDTA”) task-forces for the purpose of disrupting and dismantling illegal drug trafficking organizations; and

WHEREAS, ONDCP has announced that the City of Atlanta’s HIDTA task-force is eligible to apply for grant G13GA0003A, in the amount of five-million, two hundred seventy-seven thousand, three-hundred twenty-five dollars (\$5,277,325) of grant funding; and

WHEREAS, approved Resolution 05-R-0680 authorized the Mayor to execute agreements designating the Atlanta Police Department (“Department”) as the “pass-through” agency for HIDTA funds; and

WHEREAS, the Department wishes to apply for this grant on behalf of the Atlanta HIDTA task-force for the purpose of continuing its operations to disrupt and dismantle drug trafficking organizations.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant G13GA0003A, from the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (“ONDCP”), on behalf of the Atlanta Police Department acting as a pass-through agency for the Atlanta HIDTA task force, in the amount of five-million, two hundred seventy-seven thousand, three-hundred twenty-five dollars (\$5,277,325), for the purpose of disrupting and dismantling illegal drug trafficking organizations.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this grant from ONDCP will not require a local match.
