**RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR PROJECT NUMBER FC-6151 NOISE INSULATION PROGRAM – MISCELLANEOUS PROPERTIES, AS FOLLOWS: [I] FC-6151-A, NEW SOUTH - MIJOY, A JOINT VENTURE COMPRISED OF NEW SOUTH CONSTRUCTION COMPANY AND MIJOY INDUSTRIAL SERVICES, INC.; [II] FC-6151-B, BRYSON/BENCHMARK, A JOINT VENTURE COMPRISED OF BRYSON CONSTRUCTORS, INC., AND BENCHMARK MANAGEMENT, LLC; [III] FC-6151-C, J.E. DUNN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY; AND [IV] FC-6151-D, WINTER JOHNSON GROUP, A JOINT VENTURE COMPRISED OF THE WINTER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY AND JOHNSON CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, FC-6151-D, TO PROVIDE NOISE INSULATION PROGRAM SERVICES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION ON A TASK ORDER BASIS AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A JOINT TASK ORDER FUND IN AN INITIAL NOT TO EXCEED COLLECTIVE AMOUNT OF \$20,000,00. FOR USE UNDER THE FOUR NOISE INSULATION PROGRAM AGREEMENTS. ALL SERVICES WILL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM PTAE0/FDOAS LISTED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”), Department of Aviation Project Development Division is currently engaged in certain noise insulation program projects ("Projects") to remediate aircraft noise-sensitive structures in proximity to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (“Airport”); and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide relief from aircraft noise to the owners of eligible properties by constructing noise-reducing improvements to such properties to reduce interior noise levels; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited Request for Proposals from qualified construction firms for FC-6151, Noise Insulation Program - Miscellaneous Properties seeking assistance, as required, to perform noise insulation work in conjunction with and as requested by the Department of Aviation; and

WHEREAS, after review and evaluation of the Proponents’ qualifications and analysis of the technical proposals, the Department of Aviation Evaluation Committee, supported by the Department of Procurement and the Aviation Procurement Unit, has completed its evaluation of the proposals; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation General Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer have recommended that the Contracts for FC-6151, Noise Insulation Program - Miscellaneous Properties be awarded to four of the most responsive and responsible Proponents, as determined by the Evaluation Committee, as follows: FC-6151-A, New South - MiJoy, a Joint Venture comprised of New South Construction Company and MiJoy Industrial Services, Inc.; FC-6151-B, Bryson/BenchMark, a Joint Venture comprised of Bryson Constructors, Inc., and BenchMark Management, LLC., FC-6151-C, J.E. Dunn Construction Company and FC-6151-D, Winter Johnson Group, a Joint Venture comprised of The Winter Construction Company and Johnson Construction Services, (collectively referred to as “Contractors”); and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the Projects, the Aviation General Manager desires to set up a Joint Task Order Fund out of which monies may be dispersed by the issuance of Task Order(s) under the Contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Atlanta Contracts FC-6151, Noise Insulation Program - Miscellaneous Properties with Contractors, as follows: FC-6151-A, New South - MiJoy, a Joint Venture comprised of New South Construction Company and MiJoy Industrial Services, Inc.; FC-6151-B, Bryson/BenchMark, a Joint Venture comprised of Bryson Constructors, Inc., and BenchMark Management, LLC.; FC-6151-C, J.E. Dunn Construction Company; and FC-6151-D, Winter Johnson Group, a Joint Venture comprised of The Winter Construction Company and Johnson Construction Services, to assist the Department of Aviation with construction services for noise mitigation Projects based on actual hourly rates times the agreed upon multiplier or otherwise agreed to per the Contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the term of the Contracts shall be for three (3) years, with one (1) two (2) year renewal option at the sole discretion of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Joint Task Order Fund is established in the initial not to exceed collective amount of \$20,000,000 for the Projects for use under the Contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Aviation General Manager is authorized to issue Task Orders under the Contracts for the Projects, or any other services contemplated under the Contracts, in an initial not to exceed collective amount of \$20,000,000, pursuant to Code Section 2-1111, in the amounts and allocated to the Contracts as deemed appropriate by the Aviation General Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all contracted work will be charged to and paid for from the following PTAE0/FDOAs:
