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

A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBER YOLANDA ADREAN AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF ARCHITECTURAL, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FROM THE CHASTAIN PARK CONSERVANCY AND THE PATH FOUNDATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING DESIGNING A PATH TRAIL AND BRIDGE ALONG POWERS FERRY ROAD IN AT CHASTAIN PARK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Chastain Park located in Atlanta, Georgia, (the “Park”), is a City of Atlanta (“City”) regional park serving the needs of a large geographic area, offering several picnic structures, a playground, baseball fields and other amenities; and

WHEREAS, the Chastain Park Conservancy (“CPC”) is a 501(c)(3) dedicated to the preservation of the Park and desires to donate architectural, design and construction services for the purpose of designing a trail and bridge along Powers Ferry Road in the Park (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, CPC has partnered with the PATH Foundation, Inc., (“PATH”), a Georgia 501(c)(3) non-profit organization whose business is to design, construct, and maintain trails on behalf of public agencies with approximately fifteen years of experience building trails in the City and surrounding communities, and is dedicated to providing expertise in the planning and implementation of trail system projects and locating private funding to reduce or eliminate the cost to the City and its taxpayers to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated Project cost is Two Million Dollars and CPC and PATH intend to contribute half the cost of the Project in the amount of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation (“DPR”) desires to accept the donation of the Project from the CPC and PATH and intends to allocate an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars and No Cents (\$1,000,000.00) from the Chastain Park Trust Fund toward completion of the Project in the Park; and

WHEREAS, the City is accepts this donation is appreciative of the CPC’s and PATH’s contributions at the Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor, on behalf of the City, is authorized to accept the donation of the Project from the CPC and PATH.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City intends to allocate an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars and No Cents (\$1,000,000.00) from the Chastain Park Trust Fund toward the Project.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that to the extent that CPC and PATH are donating time and resources to the City, the City hereby accepts the donation.
