**A RESOLUTION

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WHEREAS, the Georgia Transportation Infrastructure Bank ("GTIB"), a revolving infrastructure investment fund established in 2008 by the Georgia General Assembly and administered by the State and Tollway Authority ("SRTA") provides grant and loan funding to local governments and community improvement districts for transportation improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") has received notification that the SRTA is currently accepting applications for transportation infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to submit an application for a GTIB grant or loan through the SRTA is October 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City has great need for transportation infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works Office of Transportation desires to apply for the Georgia Transportation Infrastructure Bank grant.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply for and accept the Georgia Transportation Infrastructure Bank grant.

BE THE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into any required agreements to implement the grant.

AND FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED, that this application and any agreements will not become binding upon the City, and the City will incur no liability or obligation under it until it has been approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to the State of Georgia State Road and Tollway Authority.
