A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBER IVORY LEE YOUNG, JR AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION'S LIVABLE CENTERS INITIATIVE (LCI) SUPPLEMENTAL STUDIES FOR THE VINE CITY/WASHINGTON PARK LCI IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 AND COMMUNITY CHOICES PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PUROSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) is accepting applications to conduct planning studies under its Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) Supplemental Studies and the Community Choices program; and

WHEREAS, the Livable Centers Initiative program is designed to fund local planning studies to encourage increased residential and mixed use development and connectivity through alternative transportation modes; and the LCI Supplemental Studies assist existing LCI communities implement their adopted plans through additional studies, changes to zoning and other policies; and

WHEREAS, Through the Community Choices Implementation Assistance program, ARC provides communities with pro bono technical assistance to implement innovative quality growth policies and plans; and

WHEREAS, both the LCI and the Community Choices application require a Council Resolution indicating commitment to the implementation on the project and the matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply a grant from the ARC, in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) in order to conduct a Supplemental LCI study for Transportation in the Vine City/Washington Park LCI and for Commercial Revitalization in Washington Park through the Community Choices program; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the City receives said grant, the ARC requires 20% matching funds for the grant amount approved by the ARC; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Planning has identified said matching funds for the proposed Vine City/Washington Park Supplemental LCI study.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for a grant from the Atlanta Regional Commission for the Vine City/Washington Park LCI Supplemental study for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the Atlanta Regional Commission Community Choices Program for Commercial Revitalization in Washington Park.

SECTION 3: All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
