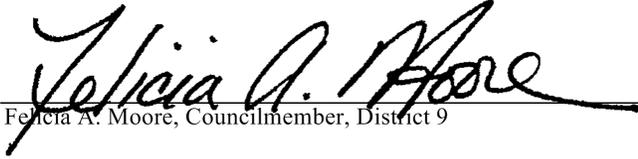

MARTIN, KWANZA HALL, JOYCE SHEPERD, ALEX WAN, AARON WATSON AND CLETA WINSLOW REQUESTING THAT THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE CORRECT THE DISPLAY OF THE AMERICAN FLAG (SIGN) AT THE I-75 EXIT TO ANDREW YOUNG INTERNATIONAL BOULEVARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, there exist a sign at the I-75 exit on to Andrew Young International Boulevard which has a display of country flags including the USA's flag ; and

WHEREAS, the current display of this flag has caused some controversy as to whether the American flag is being displayed appropriately at the location above; and

WHEREAS, members of veteran organizations have complained that the flag as displayed is done so inappropriately; and

WHEREAS, after review of information found on the internet at <http://www.ushistory.org/betsy/flagetiq.html> it suggest that the flag at the I-75 exit on to Andrew Young International Boulevard is a sign and not a flag and the union (stars) should be uppermost and to the flag's own right, that is, to the observer's left (see Attachment Item #8); and

WHEREAS, this legislation will correct what some are viewing as an obvious error and make the necessary correction that will satisfy past and present members of the military, members of the American Legion and the American people.

AND FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
