A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR THE ATLANTA CITY COUNCIL'S WEBSITE REDESIGN, DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION WITH VISION INTERNET PROVIDERS, INC. ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED -----, ALL CONTRACTED WORK TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM -----; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") aspires to provide its residents and visitors with a website that appropriately represents the City and helps residents and visitors easily locate information and services offered by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council desires to redesign and upgrade the website containing information regarding Council Members, operations and activities of the Council, and

WHEREAS, the City Council Staff has solicited quotes for the performance of website design, development and implementation services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta entered into a contract with Vision Internet Providers to redesign, develop and implement the City's Internet Website, and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council is now interested in amending the contract with Vision Internet Providers for Council website redesign, development and implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute on behalf of the Atlanta City Council, for Website Redesign, Development & Implementation Plan with Vision Internet Providers, Inc. for website design, development and implementation services in an amount not to exceed_____.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all contracted work shall be charged to and paid from fund, department organization and account number 1001(General Fund030217(Council Shared Support) 5213001(Consultant/Professional Services Tech. Governing Body(1110001).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Procurement Officer in consultation with the City Attorney is directed to prepare an appropriate document for execution by the Mayor.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the agreement will not become binding on the City, and the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney, and delivered to Vision Internet Providers, Inc.
