**A RESOLUTION
BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT WITH CYCLEHOP, LLC FOR FC-6605 SELF SERVICE BICYCLE
RENTAL PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") solicited Requests for Proposals for qualified firms for FC-6605 Self Service Bicycle Rental Program in order to implement the Citywide Bike Share Program put into place certain of the recommendations of *The Atlanta-Decatur Bike Share Feasibility Study*; and

WHEREAS, the Citywide Bike Share Program will allow the general public to rent bicycles from one of a number of stations, use the bicycle for trips of varying times and durations and return it to a different station; and

WHEREAS, self-service bicycle rental programs provide a convenience for residents, workers and visitors because bicycles are available on an as-needed basis and are available for one-way trips; and

WHEREAS, self-service bicycle rental programs can operate on a cooperative basis and link with other programs sponsored by other entities to grow the system quickly and expand the reach of the program beyond the City; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning & Community Development believes that allowing self-service bike stations in the public right-of-way would allow a program to be implemented without the investment of capital by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Requests for Proposals sought to identify an operator that would offer to contract with the City to provide a system that would supply no less than 500 bicycles in the first year of operation with no investment of capital by the City; and

WHEREAS, any risk to allowing the use of the City's right-of-way can be offset by insurance and bonding requirements in the contract; and

WHEREAS, the agreement is for a base term of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Planning & Community Development and the Chief Procurement Officer have recommended that the contract for FC-6605, Self Service Bicycle Rental Program be awarded to CycleHop, LLC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES, the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with CycleHop, LLC for FC-6605, Self Service Bicycle Rental Program, on behalf of the Department of Planning & Community Development that will allow CycleHop, LLC to install bike share infrastructure on public

property and/or the right-of-way with the approval of the Department of Public Works and manage the Self Service Bicycle Rental Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to prepare the contract authorized by this resolution for execution by the Mayor.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City shall provide no funding for the installation of the infrastructure.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the base term of the contract shall be five (5) years with any extension to be solely at the discretion of the city provided however that such extension shall not be for more than five (5) additional years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Notice to Proceed to be issued to CycleHop, LLC under the contract authorized by this resolution shall be contingent on the amendment of Chapter 138 of the City Code to allow the erection of bike share infrastructure on public property and/or the public right-of-way.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that said contract shall not become binding upon the City and the City shall incur no liability upon the same, until such contract is approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the contracting parties and delivered to the City, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and a fully executed copy delivered to the contracting party.
