



AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO REMOVE PARKING RESTRICTION ON SUNDAYS ALONG THE SOUTH CURBLINE OF ELLIS STREET BETWEEN COURTLAND STREET AND PIEDMONT AVENUE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Mount Vernon Baptist Church is temporally relocating to the former Atlanta Fire Station site located at 125 Ellis Street which is located on Ellis Street between Courtland Street and Piedmont Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the building lacks off-street parking and on-street parking is prohibited; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works received a request from Mount Vernon Baptist Church to remove parking restriction on Sundays; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works evaluated the request and Ellis Street is a major route providing access to I-85/75 but traffic volume is relatively low on Sundays; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works does not envision significant impact associated with removing parking restriction on Sundays only.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, or his designee is authorized to allow parking on Sundays only along the south curb line of Ellis Street between Courtland Street and Piedmont Avenue.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed in this instance only.
