AN ORDINANCE TO DONATE \$20,500.00 TO THE CIVIL WAR SESQUICENTENNIAL COMMISSION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING THE COMMISSION TO COMMEMORATE THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CIVIL WAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a series of Civil War Battles were fought in the City of Atlanta ("City") during the summer of 1864; and

WHEREAS, this summer is the sesquicentennial and 150th anniversary of those events; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 13-R-3780, adopted by the City Council on November 18, 2013 and approved as per City Charter Section 2-403 on November 27, 2013, established the Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission to create continuity between the multiple organizations in the City working to commemorate the sesquicentennial; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council supports commemorating the 150th Anniversary of the Civil War and wishes to donate \$20,500.00 to the Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized, upon receipt of proper documentation, to remit payment to the Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission in the amount of \$20,500.00

SECTION 2: That all payments will be recorded to Council Member Carry Forward accounts as shown on Exhibit A and shall be charged to and paid from the following:

SECTION 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed for purposes of this ordinance only, and only to the extent of the conflict.

Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission

The Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission was established to commemorate, city-wide, the 150th anniversary of the Atlanta Campaign. Special focus is given to its importance in shaping the history of the City of Atlanta up through the present day with the theme: *From Civil War to Civil Rights*.

The Atlanta Campaign touched the following communities and involves the following venues/organizations:

- East Atlanta - site of the Battle of Atlanta
- Peachtree Battle - actual Battle site
- Ezra Church - actual battle site
- Carter Center/Copenhill - Sherman's Temporary headquarters
- Cyclorama
- Oakland Cemetery - Union & Confederate burial ground
- Margaret Mitchell House
- Wren's Nest - letters written by children hiding during the civil war were found in the attic
- Fort Walker - erected just before the war and preserved near Grant Park
- City-wide – street banners commemorating the 150th anniversary
- City-wide – Essay Contest to educate students about the history from Civil War to Civil Rights
