

ARCHIBONG AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO WAIVE THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN CHAPTER 110, ARTICLE I, SECTION 110-3 (C) ENTITLED “ATLANTA CYCLORAMA ADMISSIONS” OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES AND SPECIFICALLY WAIVING THE ADMISSION FEE SO AS TO ALLOW FOR ACTIVE MILITARY MEMBERS AND UP TO FIVE FAMILY MEMBERS ADMISSION WITHOUT CHARGE FROM MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND, MAY 25, 2014 UNTIL LABOR DAY WEEKEND, SEPTEMBER 2, 2014, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BLUE STAR MUSEUM PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Whereas, Blue Star Museums is a collaboration among the National Endowment of the Arts, Blue Star Families, the Department of Defense, and more than 1,800 museums across America which offers free admission to families with an active duty member of their family serving during this time of combat; and

Whereas, the focus is on the approximately 1 million children who have had at least one parent deployed. This program offers these families a chance to visit museums this summer when many will have limited resources and limited time to be together; and

Whereas, the free admission program is available to any bearer of a Geneva Convention common access card (CAC), a DD Form 1173 ID card, or a DD Form 1173-1 ID card, which includes active duty U.S. military (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, active duty National Guard and Reserve components, active duty U.S. Public Health Service Commissioned Corps, active duty NOAA Commissioned Corps), and up to five family members, the military ID holder plus up to five family members, a family member of active duty military may include a spouse or child, aunts, uncles, grandparents, etc.; and

Whereas, The Blue Star Museum program runs from Memorial Day to Labor Day; and and

Whereas, the City of Atlanta ‘s Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs (“DPRCA”) is requesting that the provisions contained in Chapter 110, Article I, Section 110-3(c) entitled “Atlanta Cyclorama Admissions” of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances be waived and specifically waiving the admission fee so as to allow for active military member and up to five family members admission without charge from Memorial Day Weekend, May 25, 2013 until Labor Day Weekend, September 2, 2013, in conjunction with the Blue Start Museum Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, on behalf of the City, is authorized to waive the provisions contained in Chapter 110, Article I, Section 110-3(c) entitled “Atlanta Cyclorama Admissions” of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances and specifically waiving the admission fee so as to allow for active military member

and up to five family members admission without charge from Memorial Day Weekend, May 25, 2013 until Labor Day Weekend, September 2, 2013, in conjunction with the Blue Star Museum Program.

SECTION 2: That DPRCA will comply with all other provisions contained in Section 110-3(c) of the City Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
