WHEREAS, the Southface Energy Institute, Inc. (“Southface”) applied for and was awarded a grant for the Program by the DOE; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”) has been selected as a sub-recipient of the DOE grant to Southface in the amount of Ninety Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$90,000.00) (the “Grant Funds”); and

WHEREAS, the Grant Funds will be used to support the Mayor’s Office of Sustainability in its efforts to reduce energy consumption and increase the energy efficiency of small commercial buildings; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to anticipate and appropriate the Grant Funds.
